**MEMORANDUM INTERN**

**Tema: Participarea la vizita Comisiei de economie și securitate a AP NATO în SUA și Canada (4-8 mai 2009) și la reuniunea aniversară a NATO (11 mai 2009)**

Adunarea parlamentară a NATO organizează, în cooperare cu Congresul SUA și Parlamentul canadian, vizita la Washington și Ottawa a Comisiei pentru economie și securitate, în perioada 4-8 mai 2009.

Ținând seama de contextul economic și financiar actual, vizita va include întreveneri la Banca Mondială, Fondul Monetar Internațional, Institutul Brookings și instituții similare din Canada.

La această vizită iau parte membrii Comisiei pentru economie și securitate. Din partea Camerei Deputaților urmează să participe domnii deputați William Brînză (PD-L) și Ion Mocioalcă (PSD), membri ai delegației române.

În continuare, domnii deputați urmează să participe la reuniunea solemnă a AP NATO consacrată celei de-a 60-a aniversări a NATO. Reuniunea, care va avea loc la Roma la 11 mai, va include trei sesiuni de lucru, la care vor fi prezente personalități politice de marcă.

Acțiunile au caracter parlamentar, conform HBP nr. 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnilor deputați William Brînză și Ion Mocioalcă la aceste acțiuni;

- deplasarea să se facă pe ruta București-Paris-Washington-Ottawa-Boston-Roma-București, cu plecare în ziua de 3 mai, ora 6.50 (AF 1089) și întoarcere în ziua de 12 mai, ora 12.45 (AZ 494);

- să se acorde cazare plafon B la hotelurile recomandate de organizatori: 3 nopți la Washington, 3 nopți la Ottawa și 2 nopți la Roma;

- să se acorde diurnă categoria a II-a 100% pentru 9 ½ zile, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară, recalcularea drepturilor urmând a se face la întoarcere, pe baza documentelor justificative.
