Propunem:

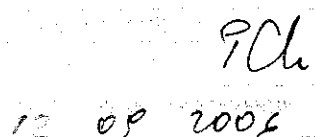

La inițiativa Parlamentului din Tanzania, a Organizației Mondiale a Parlamentarilor Împotriva Corupției (GOPAC) și a Rețelei Parlamentarilor pentru Africa Împotriva Corupției (APNAC), în perioada 20-23 septembrie 2006, la Arusha, în Tanzania, se vor desfășura lucrările celei de-a doua conferințe GOPAC. (art.3, lit.c din HBP nr.1/2003).

GOPAC este o organizație mondială cu autonomie regională a căror parlamente membre sunt angajate să reducă corupția prin creșterea eficienței parlamentelor ca instituții de supraveghere și de răspundere.

Încă de la înființare, din anul 2002, GOPAC s-a extins rapid în întreaga lume, fiind reprezentat în prezent de aproape 80 de țări. Numărul membrilor organizației continuă să crească, astfel GOPAC este recunoscută ca o puternică voce democratică ce promovează imaginea parlamentară ca fiind una dintre forțele fundamentale în lupta împotriva corupției.

Agenda reuniunii va fi structurată pe două sesiuni: a) aprobarea unui plan concret de acțiune pentru GOPAC și colaborarea cu alte organizații interesate în lupta împotriva corupției; b) dezvoltarea unor acorduri și angajamente prin urmărirea acestor planuri și transmiterea rezultatelor împotriva corupției. - Imunitatea parlamentară: Este de asemenea definită în linii mari?
- Codurile de comportament pentru parlamentari: De ce avem nevoie de ele?
- Prezentarea resurselor de venituri: Totul despre bani;
- Accesul la informație și la mass-media: Importanța transparenței.

Dear Parliamentary Delegates,

As a registered delegate to the GOPAC Conference in Arusha, we would like to remind you of some important information that is pertinent to you as a parliamentary delegate.

The Parliament of Tanzania is providing to Parliamentary delegates free of charge:

- 1) return ground transfers between the Kilimanjaro Airport and your hotel;
- 2) ground transportation between your hotel and the conference venue;
- 3) a choice of three pre-conference tours on September 19th; and
- 4) two nights pre-conference accommodation on 18th and 19th September for delegates registered in one of the pre-conference tours.

We really appreciate the hospitality extended by the Parliament of Tanzania, therefore encourage you to sign up for one of the tours.

We would be obliged if you ensure that you address the following issues, and advise the GOPAC Secretariat of your choices:

A) Have you informed the Parliament of Tanzania about the details of your arrival and departure?

The Parliament of Tanzania, as co-host of the GOPAC conference, will provide parliamentary delegates with **ground transportation to and from Kilimanjaro Airport** as well as **transportation between your hotel and the conference venue**.

Please submit your *Arrival and Departure form* in order to ensure that you are met at the airport.

B) Have you reserved your hotel?

There are four hotels to choose from, all on a bed and breakfast basis. Please ensure that you have made your reservation directly with the hotel.

Your accommodation for the nights of September 18th and 19th (room and tax only) will be paid by the

Parliament of Tanzania if you are registered to participate in one of the pre-conference tours. However, you will be responsible for all of your room costs outside of these two dates.

C) Have you registered for your Pre Conference Tour?

The Parliament of Tanzania has kindly offered to host a **Pre-Conference Tour program on September 18th and 19th, 2006** of Arusha and its surrounding areas. The Pre Conference tour is entirely paid for by the Parliament of Tanzania (as is the cost of hotel rooms for tour participants on the evenings of September 18th and 19th, 2006.)

1. **Ngorongoro Crater** : This is one of the most prestigious of the parks in Arusha and Tanzania. The famous volcanic Ngorongoro crater is the largest unbroken caldera in the world, and you will enjoy East African scenery and game.
2. **Lake Manyara National Park:**
Lake Manyara is a scenic gem, with a compact game-viewing circuit through Manyara offers a virtual microcosm of the Tanzanian safari experience.
3. **Kilimanjaro National Park (KINAPA):** Visit and "climb" the foothills of the world famous Kilimanjaro Mountain (Marangu Gate).

D) Do you have your visa to enter Tanzania?

All visitors require a visa to enter Tanzania except citizens of some African and commonwealth countries. It is advisable to obtain your visa prior to traveling to Tanzania. Some airlines may require that you show your visa before allowing you to board your flight. Information is available on the website at

Visas may be obtained in advance from the Tanzania Embassy or High Commission in your country, and a list of Tanzania Embassies abroad may be found on the website at:

E) Do you need vaccinations or health precautions?

Tanzania is a tropical country, and you should check with your personal physician or travel health clinic before departure to determine what vaccinations or precautions are recommended before you enter Tanzania.
