Tema: Conferința cu tema „Promovarea democrației: creșterea rolului diplomației parlamentare” (Georgia, 30 noiembrie - 1 decembrie 2006)

Reuniunea interparlamentară cu tema „Promovarea democrației: creșterea rolului diplomației parlamentare” a fost programată să se desfășoare, inițial, în perioada 28-29 septembrie 2006, la Tbilisi, Georgia. 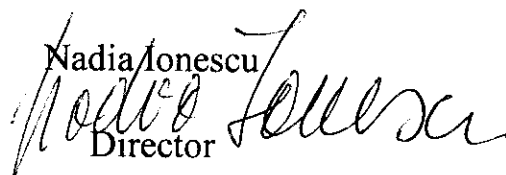
Limbile de lucru ale reuniunii sunt: georgiana, engleza și rusa. Se asigură traducere simultană.

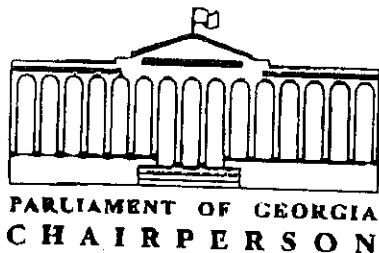
Data limită pentru înregistrarea participanților la conferință este 5 noiembrie 2006.

Inter-parliamentary Meeting

Promoting Democracy: enhancing the role of parliamentary diplomacy

30 November – 1 December 2006

General Information

Venue of the Meeting

Hotel "Marriott-Courtyard"
4, Freedom Square
Tbilisi, Georgia

All sessions will be held at the Ball-room of the hotel "Marriott-Courtyard", which is situated in the city center of Tbilisi. Public transport (bus and metro) is within walking distance from the Hotel. The state and art museums, as well as the historic areas, shops, bars and restaurants are within walking distance from the Hotel.

Hotel Accommodation

The Parliament of Georgia will cover hotel accommodation for speakers and two accompanied people at the hotel "Marriott-Courtyard". If the parliament is not represented by the speaker, the free accommodation will be provided for 2 people. The same applies to the Heads and representatives of the International and Interstate organizations. We very much appreciate if the information confirming participation of the Speaker/MPs, as well as the names of accompanied people will be communicated to the contact person by the 5th of November 2006. If you intend to have a larger delegation, you can book the rooms at the same hotel or other hotels (while booking, please refer the rooms reserved for participants of the Inter-parliamentary Meeting and inform contact person). A list of more suitable hotels (including guest-houses) is given in Appendix A. Reservations in other hotels should be made by the 10th of November 2006, after which it may not be possible to guarantee room availability. Please inform about any booking the

contact person at the Parliament of Georgia. If you have any problems with booking, please feel free to ask for assistance to the contact person.

Airport/Visa

Delegates will be met at the airport according to the preliminary communicated flight data. Shuttle coach service will be provided by the parliament. There will be a welcome desk in the VIP1 lounge of Tbilisi International Airport to greet the delegates in the best possible conditions and to avoid unpleasant situations.

Nationals of the EU member-states require no entry visa. Visa fees vary from 15 to 25 USD and it can be issued directly at the airport.

Transportation during the Forum

Coach transport will be provided to and from all social functions and for the accompanying persons' program. For hotel not being located within the walking distance from the Hotel Marriott-Courtyard, a shuttle coach service will be provided by the Parliament of Georgia.

Registration and information desk

A registration desk will be open at the Hotel Marriott-Courtyard from 10h00-19h00 on Wednesday, 29th November and from 08h00-10h00 on Thursday, 28th September. Please register as soon as possible after your arrival in Tbilisi. Those who do not stay at the Hotel Marriott-Courtyard will be able to collect badges, folders and other corresponding papers at the reception of their respective hotels.

An information desk will be open on the 2nd floor of the Hotel Marriott-Courtyard, near the ball-room throughout the Meeting to assist delegates.

Accompanying persons

A program for accompanying persons has been arranged while delegates are engaged in conference sessions. Accompanying persons will also be welcomed to Dinner and Reception hosted by the Parliament of Georgia and to the excursion on Saturday, December 2.

Medical Facilities

A first aid facility will be available for participants throughout the Meeting at the Hotel "Marriott-Courtyard". Opening hours: 8h30-20h00. In case of medical treatment or hospitalization the medical service will be provided by the Hospital identified for this purpose by the Ministry of Health, Labour and Social Affairs of Georgia.

Electricity

The electricity in Tbilisi is 220 volts. Voltage transformers for appliances that require less than 220 volts are not easily obtainable and are best brought along.

The international code for Georgia is +995 and for Tbilisi +995 32. International telephone and fax services and internet are available at all hotels and at the Forum HQ at the Hotel "Marriott-Courtyard".
