Tema: Participare la Seminarul "Operațiunile internaționale de menținere a păcii: lecții asumate" (Garmisch Partenkirchen, 26 – 29 noiembrie 2006)

În perioada 26-29 noiembrie a.c., va avea loc la Garmisch-Partenkirchen (Germania) Seminarul privitor la abilitățile de conducere intitulat: "Operațiunile internaționale de menținere a păcii: lecții asumate" în organizarea Centrului European de Studii de Securitate "George C. Marshall".

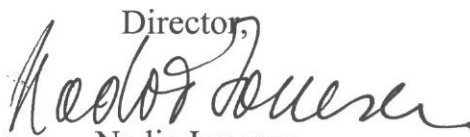
Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar, conform art. 3 lit. d) al HBP 1/2003.
