The Black Sea is an area of crucial importance for Europe, given its links with Central Europe and its access to the Mediterranean Sea and taking into account its geographical location - at the cross-roads between East and West -. In socio-economic, cultural and environmental terms, the Black Sea region is one of the most sensitive European areas.

The Congress of the Council of Europe, with the support of the Samsun Metropolitan Municipality, wish to contribute tackling the Black Sea challenges by promoting an increase in co-operation between local and regional authorities located in proximity to the Black-Sea.

The aim of the present Conference is to discuss possible co-operation initiatives in the environmental, socio-economic and cultural fields and the creation of a Black Sea Euroregional structure that could give local and regional self-government authorities a permanent co-operation framework for working together.
