Adunării Uniunii Europei Occidentale (AUEO)
(Paris, 18-20 decembrie 2006)

În perioada 18-20 decembrie a.c. urmează să se desfășoare la Paris partea a doua a celei de-a 52-a sesiuni ordinare a Adunării Uniunii Europei Occidentale (AUEO).

Pe ordinea de zi a reuniunii figurează: raportul anual al Consiliului UEO; precum și rapoartele privind **Securitatea și stabilitatea în Asia centrală; Către o soluție de durată în Orientul Mijlociu: un rol pentru Europa; NATO: transformare și parteneriat strategic cu UE; Cooperarea transatlantică în domeniul aeronautic; Adunarea UEO: un instrument pentru parlamentele naționale; Proiectul de buget al Adunării pentru anul 2007.**

De asemenea, se vor adresa plenului Adunării domnii Jaap de Hoop Scheffer, secretarul general al NATO și Günter Gloser, ministru de stat pentru Europa, reprezentând viitoarea președinție germană la UE/UEO.

Din partea delegației parlamentare române la AUEO vor participa doamnele deputate **Florina Ruxandra Jipa (PRM), Anca Petrescu (PRM)**, domnii deputați **Cristian Silviu Bușoi (PNL), Florin Iordache (PSD), Dumitru Bentu (PSD), Nicolae Popa (PC), Levente Csaba Szekely (UDMR)**, membri, precum și domnul Răzvan Tănase, secretarul delegației.

La sesiunea de la Paris a fost invitat să participe și domnul deputat **Ștefan Glăvan (PC)**, în calitate de observator oficial. Domnia se va afla în acea

perioadă la Paris la o reuniune a Consiliului Europei, în continuare urmând să participe la sesiunea AUEO.

Domnul deputat Dumitru Bentu a solicitat să efectueze deplasarea la Paris cu trenul.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar - (art. 3 lit. a. din HBP nr.1/2003).

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea delegației parlamentare române la sesiunea de la Paris;

- pentru domnul deputat **Dumitru Bentu**: deplasarea să se efectueze cu trenul pe ruta București-Viena-Paris și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 15 decembrie și întoarcere în ziua de 23 decembrie, conform traseului anexat;

- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă cat. a-IIa, 100%, pentru 6 ½ zile, drepturi de cazare, plafon B pentru 4 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;

- pentru domnul deputat **Ștefan Glăvan**: să se acorde drepturi de diurnă cat. a-IIa, 100% pentru 5 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 5 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară - (prevederile memorandumului nr.1210 din 27 octombrie 2006 se modifică în mod corespunzător în ceea ce privește deplasarea domnului deputat Ștefan Glăvan);

- pentru **restul delegației**: deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Paris și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 17 decembrie, ora 9.25 (RO 381) și întoarcere în ziua de 21 decembrie, ora 20.20 (RO 384), conform traseului anexat;

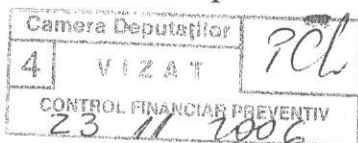
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă cat. a-II-a, 100%, pentru 4 ½ zile, drepturi de cazare, plafon B pentru 4 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;

- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

The next plenary session of the Assembly of Western European Union - the Interparliamentary European Security and Defence Assembly - will be held in Paris from Monday 18 to Wednesday 20 December 2006. The Assembly was obliged to change the planned session dates following a decision by the Conference of EU Speakers at the end of June this year to hold a second Parliamentary Meeting on the Future of Europe on 4-5 December, which will be co-hosted in Brussels by the Finnish Parliament and the European Parliament. As you are aware, talks on the issue of the EU's draft constitution are slowly being resumed and many of our members will be attending this important meeting. The Presidential Committee considers it crucial that over the coming months governments make provision for European interparliamentary scrutiny of security and defence issues in whatever text is put forward for approval in the 25 EU member states. We shall be calling on the governments and parliaments of member states over the coming months in order to submit the Assembly's proposals.

The enclosed draft Order of Business illustrates the wide range of topical issues which are scheduled for discussion at the December 2006 session. Please consult our website (<http://www.assembly-weu.eu>) for any changes to the programme.

The Assembly has decided to hold a special debate on the morning of Tuesday, 19 December open to all participants. The subject of this debate is "Towards a lasting solution for the Middle East: a role for Europe". I have great pleasure in inviting you, as a key member of your Parliament, to take part personally in this debate.

Information is attached concerning the practicalities of the session together with a reply form.

Please note that the Assembly's plenary sessions in 2007 are scheduled to take place from Monday 4 to Wednesday 6 June and from Monday 3 to Wednesday 5 December.
