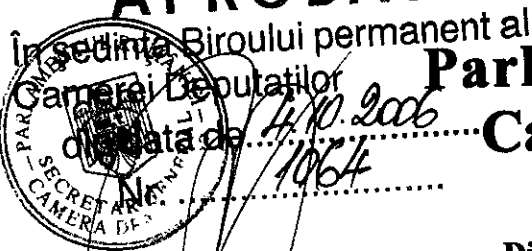

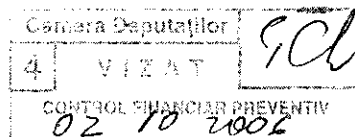
Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, alin. a. al HBP nr. 1/2003.

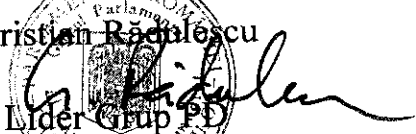
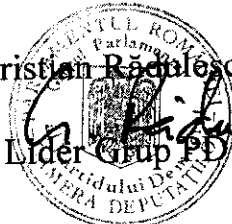
