Tema: Reuniunea parlamentară cu tema „Educație și tineret – o perspectivă europeană” (18 - 19 decembrie 2006, Bruxelles)

În perioada **18-19 decembrie** a.c., la **Bruxelles**, Parlamentul European va organiza o reuniune parlamentară cu tema **„Educație și tineret – o perspectivă europeană”**.

Reuniunea va fi deschisă de doamna **Christa Prets**, europarlamentar și președinta Comisiei pentru cultură și educație a Parlamentului European.

Vor fi dezbătute *teme de interes* în domeniul educației, precum: rolul educației în procesul de integrare europeană; perspectivele de cercetare și tineret în Balcanii de Vest în cadrul celui de al șaptelea Program cadru 2007-2013; investirea în capitalul uman; strategia Comisiei europene și prioritățile actualei Președinții finlandeze a UE în privința educației și tineretului; programe ale Comisiei europene în

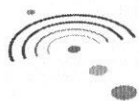
