Tema: Participarea la cea de a 28 a reuniune a Comisiei pentru probleme economice, comerciale, tehnologice și de mediu a APCEMN, 14-15 martie a.c., Atena, Grecia.

Propunem :

-deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Atena și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 13.03.2007, ora 10.05, (zbor OA 382), și întoarcerea în data de 16.03.2007, ora 18.45, (zbor OA 383);

- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II a, 50%, pentru 3 1/2 zile și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;

RECOMMENDATION 94/2007*
"State and perspectives of the fishery in the Black Sea countries"

The Parliamentary Assembly of the Organization of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation:

1. **Recognizing** the role of the living water resources as an important natural renewable source of food and traditional and important role of the fisheries in socio-economic life of the BSEC member states;
2. **Emphasizing** that effective and integrated fisheries management policies will result in long-term gain in food supply and food security, as well as in economic growth;
3. **Affirming** that concept of sustainable development should be applied in fisheries sector, including environmental protection of the fishing areas, rational use of the fishing resources and development of aquaculture;

The Assembly debate on 6 June 2007 (see Doc.: GA29/EC28/REP/07, Report of the Economic, Commercial Technological and Environmental Affairs Committee "State and perspectives of the fishery in the Black Sea countries" discussed in Athens, on 14 March 2007; Rapporteur: Mr. Boris Deych – Ukraine)

Text adopted by the Assembly in Sophia on 6 June 2007.

4. **Aware** of the fact that aquaculture has significant role in the development of the fishery sector and it needs appropriate institutional and legal frameworks for realization of its potential in accordance with the principles of sustainable development;

5. **Recognizing** the importance of inland fisheries and freshwater aquaculture in the region, in particular for land-locked countries, where freshwater fish is important for food security;

6. **Recalling** its Recommendations 54/2001 on "Promoting sustainable agriculture and rural development, and 49/2001 on "Black Sea environmental protection: new challenges";

7. **Taking into consideration** basic international legal documents, such as the 1982 United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea, Rio Declaration and Agenda 21, Kyoto and Bangkok Declarations on Aquaculture and Cancun Declaration on Responsible fishing and **appreciating** the role and huge experience of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations;

8. **Stressing** the significance of the Maritime Policy of the European Union and adoption of the Green Paper on the relevant issue;

9. **Welcoming** activities of the Black Sea Commission and establishment of the Advisory Group on Fisheries and other Marine Living Resources (AG FOMLR), as well as other regional initiatives and projects, such as the International Commission for the Protection of the Danube River;

10. **Taking into consideration** the Black Sea Environmental Program, Convention on Protection of Black Sea against Pollution and the Danube River Protection Convention;

11. **Therefore, the Assembly recommends** the Parliaments and the Governments of the BSEC Member States:

i) *to improve* legislation framework in the field of fishery and, if necessary, to *adopt* additional regulations and laws focusing on the environmental and social aspects of this sector;

ii) *to accelerate* institutional reforms in the fishing sector with the view of clear regulation of access to fisheries, legal status of stocks and privatization processes;

iii) *to define* long-term strategies in the fight against poaching, plundering of stocks and over-fishing;

iv) *to provide* for appropriate framework for the development of aquaculture with involvement of competent national research centres to initiate studies with the view to demonstrate the ecological and technical feasibility of aquaculture as well as its economic advantages;

v) *to adjust* fishing fleets to the generally accepted standards with the view of proper exploitation of the fish resources;

vi) *to develop* national policy on professional trainings for fishermen with the view of gaining knowledge on effective management of fishing resources, including preparation of qualified workers specialized in aquaculture;

v) *to establish* more effective and close cooperation with the international organizations, in particular with FAO, and to *speed up* ratification of the relevant conventions;

vi) *to promote* creation of independent agencies, which could cooperate with public authorities in monitoring state of the fishing resources, their conservation and rational management;

vii) *to intensify* cooperation with the European Union taking into consideration the EU Green Paper on the Maritime Policy;

viii) *to increase* the level of cooperation in the field of fishery between the member states on the base of bilateral or multilateral agreements;

ix) *to facilitate* elaboration and adoption of the international convention, which will regulate fishery in the Black Sea;

12. The Parliamentary Assembly invites the BSEC Council of Ministers of Foreign Affairs to consider this Recommendation.

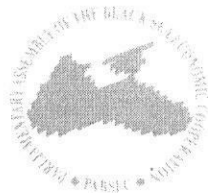

7. The date and venue of the next meeting shall be decided according to the Decision 5/1997 of the Standing Committee.
8. Following the Decision of the Bureau of 19 June 1997 the host country shall fully cover the board and lodging expenses **only for the members of the Committee and one Secretary from each delegation and the International Secretariat.**
9. The National Delegations are kindly asked to confirm their participation and provide the corresponding arrival/departure details by 1 March 2007.
