**Tema:** Participarea la cea de a 29 a reuniune a Comisiei pentru probleme economice, comerciale, tehnologice și de mediu a APCEMN, 19-20 septembrie a.c., Kiev, Ucraina.

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Budapesta-Kiev și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 18.09.2007, ora 10.40, (zbor MA 855), și întoarcere în data de 21.09.2007, ora 20.25, (zbor MA 856);
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a doua, 50%, pentru 3 1/2 zile și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

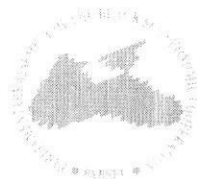

2. The main item placed on the agenda is: **‘The priorities of cooperation between the BSEC member states in the field of energy: oil and gas sector’**.

In conformity with the Decision 4/1996 of the Standing Committee, the National Delegations were requested to provide to the International Secretariat their proposals **no later than 20 August 2007**. The International Secretariat will forward the relevant documents of the meeting by 15 August 2007.

The Draft Minutes of the 28<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Committee, held on 14 March 2007 in Athens, were circulated to the National Delegations on 2 May 2007. **There will be no distribution of this document in Kyiv**. The participants are kindly requested to make sure they have a copy during the meeting.
5. The National Delegations are requested to be prepared to propose the main subject to be placed on the agenda of the next meeting of the Committee.
6. The date and venue of the next meeting shall be decided according to the Decision 5/1997 of the Standing Committee.
7. Following the Decision of the Bureau of 19 June 1997 the host country shall fully cover the board and lodging expenses **only for the members of the Committee and one Secretary from each delegation and the International Secretariat**.
8. The National Delegations are kindly asked to confirm their participation and provide the corresponding arrival/departure details by 1 September 2007.
