THE PRESIDENT

Dear Mr. Chairman-in-Office,

First of all I would like to express my gratefulness to the Turkish BSEC Chairmanship for providing the opportunity to participate in the Summit marking the 15th Anniversary of the Organization of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation in the beautiful city of Istanbul.

In my capacity as the PABSEC President, I would like to note with satisfaction the fact that the BSEC Summit Declaration emphasised the valuable role of the Parliamentary Assembly, which provides effective and close interaction among the national parliaments and consistently supports the BSEC cooperation process. I would also like to note the important role played by the Parliamentary Assembly over almost seven years in enhancing interaction with the European Parliament. Close and constructive cooperation with the BSEC has been the constant conviction of the Assembly stressing the role parliamentarians can play for greater parliamentary involvement and mobilisation of public support. In this respect, I would like to stress that the major projects elaborated and endorsed within the Organisation of the BSEC requires consolidated parliamentary support.

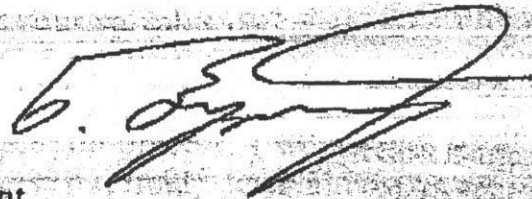
I deem it my duty to draw your kind attention to those deviations that, in my opinion, have placed the Parliamentary Assembly, its President and the International Secretariat in an inadequate position. I would like to note that although on every occasion the BSEC stresses the significance of the Parliamentary Assembly, the misunderstanding or non-coordination in the drafting process resulted that the BSEC Charter adopted by the Yalta Summit in 1998 could not determine appropriate place for the Parliamentary Assembly. Referred as "The Related Bodies to the BSEC" PABSEC shares equal terms with the Black Sea Trade and Development Bank, the BSEC Business Council, International Centre for Black Sea Studies, and other affiliated bodies. Determination of the status of the Parliamentary Assembly as "the related body" automatically deprived it of the possibility to share the status similar to the BSEC as it used to be in the first stage of the functioning of both organisations. At the same time, I would also like to draw your kind attention to the fact that it falls against the norms of ethics when on a regular basis the

representatives of the PABSEC (the International Secretariat) are requested to leave the meeting hall at the BSEC meetings when discussions continue in camera. There is no doubt that any organisation has the right to discuss the issues in camera but it is important to take the sensitivity of the issue into account when drawing up the order of business of the meetings.

I would like to conclude by expressing my sincere belief that constructive cooperation between the Organisation of the BSEC and its Parliamentary Assembly towards more effective achievement of the shared goals of the Black Sea Economic Cooperation will bring the issue of the upgrading of the status of the PABSEC in the future. Meanwhile, I would like to state my determination to spare no effort to further invigorate dialogue and partnership in order to secure a favourable political and economic environment for more enhanced cooperation in the Black Sea region.
