Following an invitation by the Secretary of the Republican Election Commission of the Republic of Serbia, the Bureau of the Assembly decided to set up an ad hoc Committee to observe the parliamentary elections which are scheduled to take place on 21 January 2007. The provisional list of members of the ad hoc Committee is attached for your information (subject to approval by the Bureau on 15 December 2006).

The ad hoc Committee will meet from Friday 19 to Monday 22 January 2007 in Belgrade. The preliminary draft programme is attached.

All members will be met at the airport and provided with transfers to the hotel. You are therefore kindly requested to inform the Secretariat about your travel details by using the attached registration form.

Members who need a visa to enter the Republic of Serbia are kindly requested to contact the nearest consular representation of Serbia in order to obtain a visa before departure to Belgrade.

The Assembly will observe these elections in several regions of the country. In line with guidelines for election observation, as amended by the Bureau on 16 November 2006, members must be ready to be deployed outside the capital city of Belgrade. You are requested to contact the Secretariat at your earliest convenience if it is impossible for you to observe outside Belgrade.

To be accredited as an international observer you will need to provide your passport and travel details as well as a recent photograph. Taking into account legal deadlines, you are requested to return the attached registration form no later than 22 December 2007 and provide us with a copy of a passport photograph in electronic (JPEG or GIF) format.
