Tema: Participarea la reuniunea Comisiei ad-hoc pentru drepturile femeii din
țările Euro-mediteraneene din cadrul Adunării Parlamentare Euro-Mediteraneene
(Bruxelles, 17 octombrie 2007)

În data de 17 octombrie 2007, la Bruxelles, va avea loc reuniunea Comisiei
ad-hoc pentru drepturile femeii din țările Euro-mediteraneene din cadrul Adunării
Parlamentare Euro-Mediteraneene (A.P.E.M.), din care face parte domnul deputat
Alecsandru Știucă (PSD), membru al Delegației Parlamentului României la
A.P.E.M.

Lucrările Comisiei vor fi consacrate analizării și dezbaterii celor două teme
propușe la ultima reuniune, „Situația și problemele femeilor imigrante” și
„Femeile în știință”, în mod special a chestionarelor pe aceste teme, completate
și transmise de țările membre. În conformitate cu recomandarea Biroului
A.P.E.M. de la Atena, din 18 mai 2007, o a treia temă va fi propusă spre
dezbateri, respectiv „accesul femeilor pe piața muncii – creșterea numărului
femeilor și copiilor”.

nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.**

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Alecsandru Știucă la
acțiunea menționată;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București –
Bruxelles și retur, cu plecare în data de 16.10.2007, ora 07.20
(RO 371) și întoarcere în data de 19.10.2007, ora 00.25
(RO 374), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100 %, pentru
3 zile și cazare plafon B pentru 3 nopți, în numerar, precum și un
avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza
documentelor justificative.

Honourable Madam President,

I would like to inform you that due to the self-dissolution of the Parliament and the coming parliamentary election in Poland, I am obliged to postpone the meeting of the ad hoc Committee on Women's Rights on Women's Rights of the Euro-Mediterranean Parliamentary Assembly scheduled on October 18 in Brussels until convening the next term of the Sejm of the Republic of Poland.

Moreover, I would like to inform you that according to decisions taken during the last meeting of Bureau in May 18, in Athens and the last meeting of the Committee in May 31, in Warsaw, the ad hoc Committee focused on:

- situations and problems of immigrant women*
- women in science,*
- follow-up of the ad-hoc Committee's Recommendation and of the EMPA Final Declaration adopted in Tunis (establishing objectives for the Committee's following work).*

Furthermore, the Secretariat of the ad hoc Committee has prepared two questionnaires which have been sent out to all of the members of the Euro-Mediterranean Parliamentary Assembly. The first survey concerns with immigrant women. First of all, the ad hoc Committee is trying to compare how immigration flows of women have changed and what has triggered them to leave their home country. Also it is important to learn what the lives of those women in their host countries are. The ad hoc Committee would like to know if women speak the language of the host country, what the hardest aspects of adjusting to a new environment are, and are there any programmes or agencies that help those women in starting and leading a new life in a new place.

Second survey regards women in science. The questions will help the ad hoc Committee in understanding how many women in those countries have decided to continue their education after earning a Master's degree. At the same time the ad hoc Committee would like to understand what

obstacles those women have had to overcome, how those obstacles have changed over the years, and are there any programmes or agencies that help those women in pursuing higher education.

The responses to aforementioned surveys will be discussed on the next meeting of the ad hoc Committee as well as according to the recommendation of the Bureau of the Euro-Mediterranean Parliamentary Assembly in Athens, 18th May 2007, a third topic on "employment and women – upbringing children and women" will be introduced during the next meeting.

According to the final conclusion of the last session of the ad hoc Committee on Women's Rights in the Euro-Mediterranean Countries, the ad hoc Committee agreed on the setting-up of 2 teams for preparing the particular parts of the report as follows:

1. Mrs Rodi Kratsa prepares information concern regulatory frameworks in the EU and the EMPA countries

Mrs Lale Akgün collates information from the questionnaires and supplement the report with her notes and comments in order to elaborate on the topic

Mrs Souâd Krafess and Mrs Salwa Terzi collect information on legal provisions and social problems in the Mediterranean Partnership Countries

2. Mr Mohamed El Ansari prepares information on women and science.

The rapporteurs to the above mentioned topics have already received the completed questionnaires which had been sent to the Secretariat so far in order to let the rapporteurs start working on the draft report. The missing questionnaires, flooded to the Secretariat, will be systematically forwarded to the rapporteurs.

Taking into consideration the ongoing work of the Committee, I am convinced that the postponement of the meeting will not cause any obstruction of the Committee's activities.

Please accept assurances of my highest esteem.
