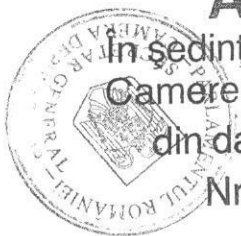
La 18 ianuarie 2007, la Londra, va avea loc reuniunea Comisiei pentru probleme economice și dezvoltare a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei, în care este membru domnul deputat Relu Fenechiu (PNL). Pe agenda reuniunii se află informări și schimburi de vedere cu reprezentanții Băncii Europene pentru Reconstrucție și Dezvoltare privind Contribuția BERD la dezvoltarea economică în Europa centrală și de est, precum și dezbaterile unor rapoarte precum „Necesitatea unei Convenții a Consiliului Europei privind suprimarea bunurilor contrafăcute și a traficării acestora”, elaborat de parlamentarul francez Bernard Schreiner și „Banca Europeană pentru Reconstrucție și Dezvoltare: focalizarea pe Europa de sud-est” al parlamentarului spaniol Carles Gasoliba.

În perioada 21 - 26 ianuarie 2007, la Strasbourg se va desfășura prima parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2007 a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei, la care participă Delegația Parlamentului României la A.P.C.E. a cărui membru este și domnul deputat Relu Fenechiu.
