A fost analizata situatia migratiei in Grecia, tara devenita dupa 1990 destinatie pentru emigratia din zona mediteraneana si s-a concluzionat necesitatea tratarii problemei migratiei drept una globala,europeana si in nici un caz una nationala.

Este nevoie de colaborare intre tarile vizate, este nevoie de programe de dezvoltare a tarilor sursa de emigratie si de solutionarea cat mai corecta a problemelor migratiei si refugiatilor, atat pentru acestia cat si pentru cetatenii tarilor destinatie.

S-a decis infiintarea unui observator euromediteranean pentru migratii prin incheierea unui parteneriat intre Comisia pentru ferugiati a APCE si Comisia de resort a parlamentului elen.
