Of elementary importance

Slovenian Biomass Association President Martina Sumenjak Sabol explains why renewable energy is South East Europe's strategy cornerstone...

Since 2001, the Slovenian Biomass Association has been organising yearly conferences for Renewable Energy in South East Europe (SEE) in the Hall of the National Council of the Republic of Slovenia.

This year's SLOBIOM conference, on the 8th and 9th October is focusing on the enforcement of the co-operation between the SEE and European Union (EU) countries to reach the renewable energy era as soon as possible, because to overcome climate change, we need to finalise the energy transition much quicker, than the EU is planning. We are inviting the European Commission to present how the EU needs to plan to reach the accepted goals by 2020. The Ministerial Round Table is also focusing on the country's plans for renewable energy and energy efficiency as a cornerstone of the energy strategy; the round tables of parliamentarians and mayors to improve the harmonisation of legislation for sustainable energy development, and to promote the most promising municipalities' practices for utilising renewable energy sources. Recent progress in some renewable energy technologies will be presented in the last session and in the pre-session, along with a presentation of the main obstacles in renewable energy implementation in SEE countries.

Another topic is a detailed discussion of the various reasons why nuclear energy is not the solution to global warming or the security of energy supply. As discussed at the 2005 Ljubljana Conference by Ernest Sternglass, Professor Emeritus of Radiology at the University of Pittsburgh and Director of the Radiation and Public Health Project (www.radiation.org), it is the unexpected damage to human health from the permitted daily radioactive airborne and liquid releases of the nuclear reactors and reprocessing facilities that account for the greatest cost to society. This has been a neglected factor in the sharply rising cost of medical care and disability payments, which, in turn, have led to a reduction in personal savings and increasing bankruptcies, together with growing budget deficits in countries with large numbers of reactors near to population centres such as in Japan and the USA. The total mortality of all ages has also failed to decline from the pre-war rate; since 1945 to 2005, excess deaths in the USA were above normal expectations, reaching a total close to 23 million.

We will be faced with a serious global disaster if new nuclear reactors are built and operations continue at existing ones. Professor Sternglass has suggested to convert them to natural gas until renewable sources, which are presently under rapid development, are able to take their place. Thus, there are no security or economic reasons to prolong the suffering of today's and future generations caused by the unexpectedly high sensitivity of humans to low amounts of nuclear fission products that are inhaled or ingested, compared with external sources of radiation (www.euradcom.org). There is also the risk of major radioactive releases resulting from either human error or earthquakes, and due to the finite supply of economically accessible uranium ore, the unsolved problem of permanent storage of long-lived radioactive waste and the high cost of enriching the uranium, all of which contribute to the high direct cost of the nuclear energy cycle.

To stop climate change and other global problems requires an interdisciplinary global solution. It is not enough to just reconstruct the energy sector – we should, of course, make progress in all sectors to make a low carbon future, including those affecting our daily lives, ie. securing natural products so that food is healthy for every country in the World. Therefore, in the future, organic agriculture is of elementary importance for the wealth and prosperity of our society.

Participation in the Slovenia SLOBIOM World Conference in June 2008, on renewable energy and raw materials, organic agriculture and healthy food, and overcoming climate change over the globe, is welcomed.

RES for the 21st Century

This should be the strategy for SEE...

In 2006, the Slovenian Biomass Association organised the 5th conference on renewables in South East Europe (SEE). The conference focused on the effects of the Kyoto Protocol in SEE.

This important conference in the Hall of the National Council of the Republic of Slovenia was attended by many high ranking experts from Europe and overseas, as well as government representatives, parliamentarians and municipality representatives, also Janos Pasztor, Financial and Technical Support Programme Officer-in-Charge of Project-Based Mechanisms, UNFCCC Secretariat, Angela Bardenhewer-Rating, Cabinet Member of the EU Energy Commissioner Andris Piebalgs and William Gillet, Head of the Intelligent Energy Unit, European Commission, to explain the future European energy development policy.

Hans-Josef Fell, Member of German Bundestag pointed out that renewables are the only future energy option. Janos Pasztor announced that for the realisation of Kyoto Protocol, domestic action is the focus and renewables have a key role there.

Angela Bardenhewer-Rating presented the actual primary energy situation in EU: 37% oil; 24% natural gas; 18% solids; 15% nuclear; 6% renewables. Import dependency at present is more than 50% and will increase to around 70% in 2030. Import dependency on oil and gas will go up significantly and is estimated to reach 90% for oil and 80% for gas. The 12% renewables target for 2010 may not be met, now at 6% share; the renewables share in total energy consumption might only reach 8% in 2010, unless Member States increase their efforts substantially.

Conclusions of the conference SLOBIOM 2006:

- ☐ To realise Kyoto protocol the EU and Member State levels, Renewable Energy Sources (RES) must have the highest priority;

- ☐ Each SEE country should also develop their own national programme for RES implementation as a top priority;
- ☐ Until now, the development of RES has not been connected with natural capability, but with stimulative instruments, which are available for all countries – it can be done;
- ☐ Some countries have achieved remarkable development of all RES with appropriate instruments;
- ☐ The instruments for RES development are only good, if they bring results.

All countries should pass laws regarding RES, based on the best experiences because:

- ☐ RES are sustainable and ecologically acceptable energy sources;
- ☐ Fossil and nuclear fuels are ecologically not acceptable, beside that we will soon be faced with a lack of them – their price will therefore rise dramatically;
- ☐ With widespread use, the cost of RES will go down;
- ☐ TRES create, countrywide, more jobs than fossil and nuclear fuels;
- ☐ TRES give an opportunity of local and regional development;
- ☐ TRES give a long-term security of energy supply.

It is important to achieve awareness among the classical energy companies and to continually perform informing and

educating on all levels, from politicians and experts to schools and the general population, about the advantages of RES in comparison with the coal, petroleum, natural gas and uranium.

For the creation of State laws, the Parliaments are responsible, which can – in co-operation with experts – prepare motions for laws.

Positive accessions, achievements and results should be continually transferred among all countries.

Therefore, the next conference, SLOBIOM 2007, RES a Cornerstone for the Energy Strategy in SEE, will be on 8th and 9th October in the Hall of the National Council of Slovenia, in Ljubljana.

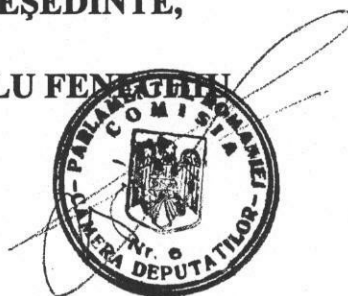
