Precizăm că organizatorii acoperă cheltuielile privind cazarea participanților precum și micul dejun.

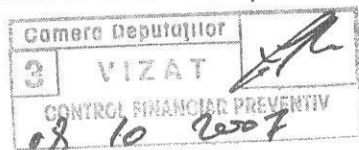
Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, lit.a, din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr.5/2007.

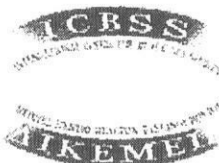

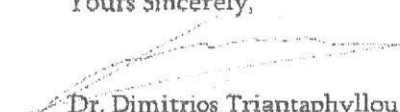
The organisers will cover the cost of your accommodation inclusive of breakfast, for the necessary number of nights. The working languages of the conference will be English and Russian.

I hope you will respond positively to our invitation as soon as possible, at the latest by 10 October. Upon receipt of your participation form we will send you further information regarding the conference logistics.

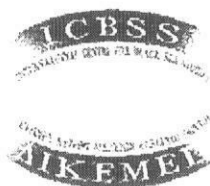

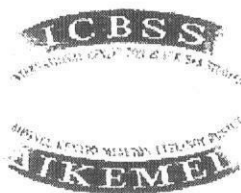
