Domnul Alexey Kudriavtsev, Secretar General al Adunării Parlamentare pentru Cooperare Economică la Marea Neagră (APCEMN), a transmis domnului deputat Mircea Ciopraga, șeful delegației Parlamentului României la APCEMN, invitația de a reprezenta această organizație la lucrările celui de al 67 lea Seminar Rose Roth organizat de Adunarea Parlamentară NATO.

- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă conform art. 29, lit.c din HBP 5/2007;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

Further to the circular 12675 07 E, I would like to provide you with some more practical information concerning the Seminar in Belgrade.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION

As you know there will not be organised transportation **between the airport and the hotel**.

Should members not be assisted by their respective embassies, as a reminder, the Hotel Slavija has a shuttle bus service between the hotel and the airport every full hour from 5:00 am to 21:00 pm. The cost of the shuttle bus is about 2€.

Taxis will also be available at the airport. The cost for one way is about 10-15 euros. Please provide me with the travel arrangements of the participants so that our hosts can make sure that there are enough taxis at the airport.

For all transfers **between the hotel and the Parliament**, our hosts will provide a coach or mini bus between the Hotel Slavija and the Parliament. A member of staff of the Parliament of Serbia will escort you to the meeting venue on Thursday 25 October.

ENGLISH/FRENCH INTERPRETATION

The NATO PA usually has an arrangement with the NATO interpreters for the Rose-Roth Seminars, but as they have a very heavy workload in October, I need to inform them if we require their services by the end of this month and before we all leave for Iceland. I would be extremely grateful if you could let me know as soon as possible whether French interpretation is required for the members of your delegation. A provisional participant list is attached.

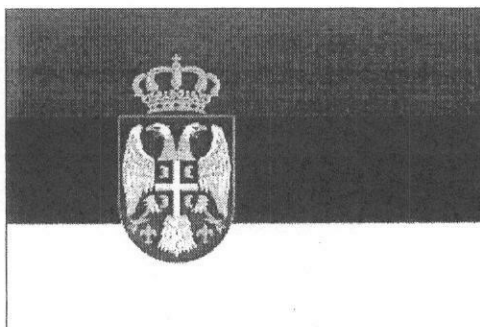
