În baza invitațiilor adresate nominal de către domnul Peter Goetz, președintele Consiliului Director pentru Europa al GPH, Comisia pentru administrație publică, amenajarea teritoriului și echilibru ecologic a desemnat în vederea participării la lucrările celei de-a XXI-a sesiune a Programului Națiunilor Unite pentru Așezări Omenești (UN-HABITAT), care se vor desfășura în perioada 16-20 aprilie 2007, la Nairobi, Kenya, pe domnii deputați Traian Constantin Igaș (PD), vicepreședinte al comisiei, vicepreședinte al Biroului Consiliului Director al Parlamentarilor Lumii pentru Habitat pentru Europa (GPH), Seres Denes (UDMR), secretar al comisiei, membru al Biroului Consiliului Director al GPH și Ioan Țundrea (PC), membru al aceleiași comisii, membru al Biroului Consiliului Director al GPH. De asemenea, din partea Comisiei pentru administrație publică, amenajarea teritoriului și echilibru ecologic a fost propusă doamna consilier Mona Petri.

Cea de-a XXI-a sesiune a programului UN-HABITAT pentru Așezări Omenești va dezbate, ca temă principală „Urbanizarea durabilă: acțiune la nivel local în vederea reducerii sărăciei urbane cu accent pe finanțare și planificare”, iar agenda reuniunii va cuprinde următoarele probleme:

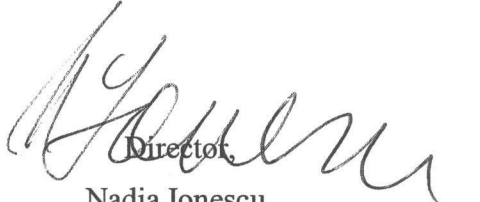
- alegerea membrilor Consiliului de conducere al UN-HABITAT pentru Așezări Omenești;
- adoptarea agendei de lucru;
- prezentarea scrisorilor de acreditare;
- activități ale Programului UN-HABITAT pentru Așezări Omenești și coordonarea problemelor în atenție;
- dezbateri pe tema principală a celei de-a XXI-a sesiuni a Consiliului de conducere al Programului UN-HABITAT pentru Așezări Omenești;
- adoptarea agendei de lucru, a bugetului Programului UN-HABITAT, precum și a fondurilor pentru Așezări Omenești, pentru perioada 2008-2009;

- adoptarea planului strategic și instituțional pe termen mediu pentru UN-HABITAT pentru perioada 2008-2013;
- adoptarea proiectului de program provizoriu pentru cea de-a XXII-a sesiune a Consiliului de conducere al UN-HABITAT;
- adoptarea raportului sesiunii.

Propunem:

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Dubai-Nairobi și retur, cu plecare în data de 14 aprilie a.c., orele 20.30, zbor RO 65 și întoarcere în data de 22 aprilie a.c., orele 7.55, zbor RO 66;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru zile 7^{1/2}, cazare plafon B pentru 6 nopți la hotelul recomandat de către organizatori "Sarova Stanley", – (210 dolari), precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- să se suporte din bugetul Camerei Deputaților contravaloarea vizei pentru Kenya, precum și contravaloarea vaccinului pentru Kenya pentru întreaga delegație;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se efectueze la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

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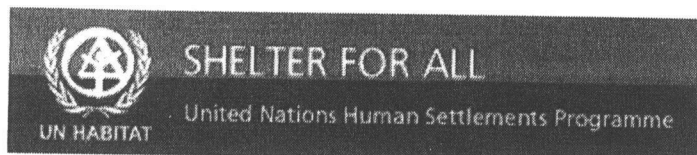
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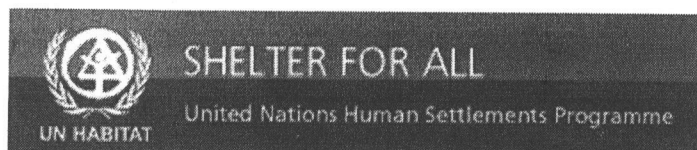
21st Governing Council

The 21st Session of the Governing Council of the United Nations Human Settlements Programme, (UN-HABITAT) will be held from 16 to 20 April 2007 at the UN-HABITAT headquarters in Nairobi, Kenya. The session focused on the main theme of *Sustainable Urbanization: local action for urban poverty reduction with an emphasis on finance and planning*.

The Governing Council meets every two years to examine UN-HABITAT's work and relationships with its partners. The Council is composed of 58 member states. It is a high-level forum of governments at the ministerial level during which policy guidelines and the organisation's budget are established for the next two-year period.

The Governing Council reports to the General Assembly through the Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) which coordinates the work of the subsidiary bodies of the General Assembly. The governments have representatives in Nairobi with whom senior UN-HABITAT officials meet regularly throughout the year in the Committee of Permanent Representatives (CPR).

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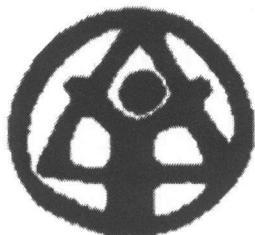

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Berlin/Brussels, 9 March 2007

Summary Minutes of the Meeting of the Presidium of the Global Parliamentarians on Habitat Europe on 2 March 2007 in Brussels, Belgium

After the welcome Peter Götz thanked Messrs Paul Taylor and Jean Bakole for the hospitality which had been extended for many years to the European members of *Global Parliamentarians on Habitat* (GPH) by the UN Habitat Office.

In his greeting Mr Taylor declared that UN Habitat considered it important to be able to host the GPH since it underlined the cooperation which was vital for political work. He pointed out that in the medium term the UN faced major institutional changes, which would also have a considerable impact on UN Habitat. The new focus on supporting sustainable urban planning, for example, created a new keynote area for the organisation, which included among its topics the subject of growing urban poverty. He pointed out that one billion of the earth's six billion people were now affected by it.

Mr Taylor said that higher priority was being given to urban environmental policy and that global environmental questions were becoming increasingly important. According to him, 80 per cent of greenhouse gas emissions originated from urban agglomerations. For this reason, efforts were needed to make structural changes to the system. Clear measuring criteria were to be developed to make it easier to gauge progress. These included a new monitoring system. Efforts were being made to develop a radical verification process to identify what action countries were taking. For Habitat this meant more decentralisation.

He invited the members of the Presidium of the GPH to attend the *Governing Council* in Nairobi, Kenya, in April 2007.

Peter Götz thanked Mr Taylor for his report and offered support and cooperation. He referred to the study of comparative legislation initiated by the GPH which was presented last year in The Hague and Vancouver. This study highlighted deficits in legislation which could be rectified by better laws on sustainable urban development policy.

Mr Münir Erkal from Turkey urged that more room should be made for the topic of global warming in the work of Habitat, too. This was agreed.

- Item 1: Report on the meeting of the Board of Directors in Mexico City on 6 February 2007 and**
Item 2: The future of the Global Parliamentarians on Habitat – Changes of personnel on the Board of Directors

Peter Götz reported to the meeting on the outcome of the deliberations of the *Board of Directors* in Mexico on 6 February 2007 and the decisions on personnel matters taken there.

He said it had been decided that temporarily until the next regular elections, the President representing America, Senator Eloy Cantú Segovia, would head up the *Board of Directors* as *Alternate President*. The Senator had held the position of *Alternate President* for many years already. He was also preparing the world forum planned for South America.

Peter Götz also reported that he had received a proposal and request from the Mexican members for him to stand as President of the *Board of Directors* and that he was prepared to put his name forward as a candidate. The decision would be made at the appropriate time. He offered to give full backing to the new *Alternate President*, Eloy Cantú Segovia. It was agreed that the next steps would be decided at a meeting of the *Board of Directors* on the occasion of the *Governing Council* in Nairobi in April of this year. During this meeting, the question concerning the leadership of the Africa and Asia groups would be discussed as well. The African President was no longer politically active and the Asian President, Senator Rodolfo G. Biazon, had informed Ernesto Gil Elorduy that he would not be standing again.

- Item 3: Change to the statute of the Global Parliamentarians on Habitat**

Discussion on the advertised change to the statute was postponed to the next meeting of the *Board of Directors* in Nairobi.

- Item 4: Comparative study "Implementing the Goals and Principles of the Habitat Agenda, adopted in Istanbul in 1996, in the legislation of the Federal Republic of Germany, Finland, the Netherlands, Romania and Turkey during the period 1996-2005"**

Peter Götz reported on the talks he and Dr. Anneke Assen had held with the EU Commission at the *EuropeAid Co-operation Office* in Brussels on 1 March 2007 on expanding the study and exploring the possibility of this expansion being financed as an EU project. He said the talks had made positive progress and further talks with other discussion partners had been envisaged.

Dr. Assen elaborated further on the outcome of the negotiations, saying that it was a matter of finding partners in the EU who understood the holistic and integrative approach. Further progress was made more complicated by the fact that in the EU Commission several directorates-general were affected and none therefore felt truly responsible. Dr. Assen and Peter Götz were asked to pursue the project further.

Item 5: UN-Habitat Governing Council in Nairobi, Kenya from 16 to 20 April 2007

Peter Götz reported that, as mentioned, the *Governing Council* was taking place in Nairobi and that a meeting of parliamentarians was also to be held there. In addition it was intended to present the study and to hand over a copy to Executive Director Dr. Anna Tibaijuka. He said he would invite the members of the European Presidium to the meeting.

Item 6: World Forum of the Global Parliamentarians on Habitat

It was reported that Chile or Argentina were the probable venues for the next world forum planned for 2008. If this were not feasible, Cancún, Mexico (10 years after Cancún) was also in the frame. America would have its turn again after Cancún, Mexico (1998), Manila, Philippines (2000), Berlin, Germany (2003) and Rabat, Morocco (2005).

Mr Münir Erkal reported that he had been asked by the Mayor of Ankara to convey an invitation to stage the next GPH world forum there. This was noted with appreciation. The invitation would be followed up depending on developments in South America. Peter Götz assured that the offer would be discussed at the next meeting of the *Board of Directors* in Nairobi.

Item 7: Miscellaneous

The next subject under discussion was the staging of the 2008 GPH European conference.

Traian Constantin Igas from Romania stated that he was in talks with both Romanian chambers. Against this background, he expressed the wish that Senator Bobes be invited to the meeting of the Presidium. He believed he would have information to provide by the end of May 2007.

Mr Erkal suggested that a summary of the work of the GPH be supplied to the Presidents and Speakers of Parliaments since many parliaments were unaware of the important work being done here. He also suggested that, rather than meeting only in Brussels, consideration should be given to staging meetings in different countries and holding talks with parliamentary colleagues, ministers and other representatives there. This was welcomed by the majority, although Brussels had proved a good choice because it was strategically well placed and easily accessible.

It was agreed that

- Peter Götz would write to the Presidents and Speakers of Parliaments and Senates, sending a copy of each letter to the members of the Presidium;
- The question of the venue for the Presidium meetings would be placed on the agenda of the next meeting;
- The date of the next meeting (probably September/October 2007) would be fixed depending on the progress of the discussions in Nairobi and/or preparations for the European Conference in Romania.
