Propunem:

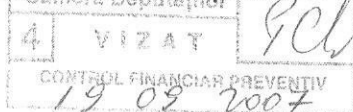
- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputate Florentina Toma și a domnului deputat George Băeșu la această acțiune;

Member of the Committee on Legal Affairs and Human Rights

Over the last few years Europe has promoted several initiatives concerning the abolition of the death penalty. Since 1997 no capital punishment has been undertaken in any of the 47 member States of the Council of Europe, including the 27 European Union Member States. A new initiative will take place in Lisbon this year. During an International Conference on 9 October, the First European Day against the Death Penalty – 10 October - will be launched, through the signature of a Joint Declaration by the European Parliament, the EU Presidency, the European Commission and the Council of Europe.

The death penalty is contrary to the fundamental rights on which the European Union and the Council of Europe are founded. Therefore, this event seeks to encourage public debate, to strengthen public opposition and to pressure retentionist countries to abolish the death penalty.

Therefore, on behalf of the Portuguese Presidency of the European Union Council, the European Commission and the Council of Europe, it is with great pleasure that we invite you to attend to this conference. It would, in fact, be an honour to have your presence in this event, which will be attended by the President and the Vice-President of the European Commission, the Secretary General of the Council of Europe, the

Chairman of the Committee of Ministers, the President of the Parliamentary Assembly, the Portuguese Prime Minister, as well as the Minister of Justice of Portugal.

The conference (in Portuguese, English and French) will start at 10.00 with an opening session, followed by the establishment of the "European Day against the Death Penalty". A press conference will follow and lead to the first set of speeches on the subject – *"The Death Penalty: an offence to human dignity"*.

After a lunch break, three consecutive sessions will be held on the following issues: *"The Death Penalty: the global context"*, *"The Death Penalty: Europe as a death-penalty free zone"* and *"The Death Penalty: actions at national level and civil society"*.

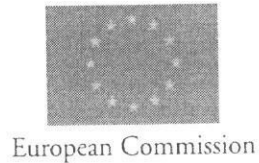
