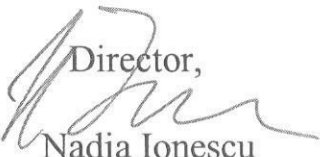
Acțiunea se încadrează în prevederile art. 5, lit. b din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București - Istanbul - Kuala Lumpur - Denpasar - Singapore - Istanbul - București, cu plecare la 1 decembrie a.c., orele 10.45 (zbor TK 1444) și întoarcere la 16 decembrie a.c., orele 11.55 (zbor RO 262), conform solicitării domnului deputat.

- să se acorde cazare plafon A, în numerar, pentru 13 nopți în Bali (rezervarea a fost efectuată prin intermediul Ambasadei României în Indonezia).
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a I-a, 100%, pentru 15 ½ zile.
- Direcția de protocol să asigure obținerea vizei necesare.

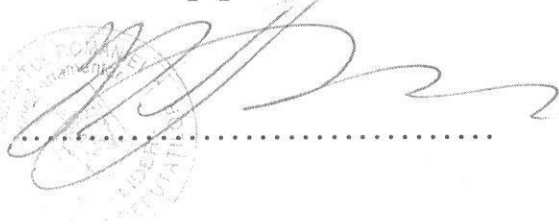

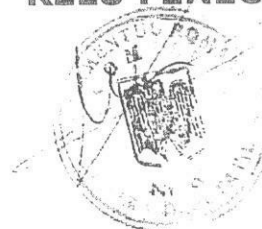

INFORMATION NOTE

**Venue of the thirteenth session of the Conference of the Parties (COP 13) and
the third session of the meeting of the Parties to the Kyoto Protocol (CMP 3)
Nusa Dua, Bali, 3 to 14 December 2007**

I am pleased to inform Parties, observer States and observer organizations to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and its Kyoto Protocol that the Bureau of the Convention met on Tuesday, 13 February 2007 and decided to accept with gratitude, the offer by the Government of Indonesia to host COP 13 and COP/MOP 3 at the Bali International Conference Centre and the adjacent facilities and services in Nusa Dua.

The Bureau requested the secretariat to complete the corresponding host country agreement with Indonesia in time for the sessions of the Subsidiary Bodies in May 2007.

The Bureau also noted that additional investments in infrastructure will be required to hold the conference and welcome the decision of the Government of Indonesia to build temporary structures and additional services as required in an appropriate timeframe.

The formal notification, containing the provisional agendas and other details concerning the above-mentioned sessions, will be sent to Parties and observers in due course.

The COP, at its fifth session, could not reach a conclusion on this matter (FCCC/CP/1999/6, para. 18), and following rule 10 (c) and rule 16 of the draft rules of procedure being applied, the item was included in the provisional agenda for the sixth up to and including the twelfth sessions with a footnote reflecting a proposal made by the Group of 77 and China to amend the item to read “Review of the adequacy of implementation of Article 4, paragraph 2 (a) and (b), of the Convention”. Annex II

Protocol Issues

Credentials of States Parties to the Convention

In accordance with rule 19 of the draft rules of procedure being applied (FCCC/CP/1996/2), the credentials of representatives of Parties, as well as the names of alternate representatives and advisers, shall be submitted to the secretariat not later than 24 hours after the opening of the session. Any later change in the composition of the delegation shall also be communicated to the secretariat.

The credentials must be issued by the head of State or Government or by the Minister of Foreign Affairs or, in the case of a regional economic integration organization, by a competent authority of that organization.

The secretariat wishes to remind Parties that, in accordance with decisions 17/CP.9 and 36/CMP.1, only one set of credentials is necessary to cover the participation of Parties to the Convention and Parties to the Kyoto Protocol in the COP at its thirteenth session and the CMP at its third session.

Parties are requested to provide their representatives with full powers to participate in the sessions, including the authority to adopt decisions, to vote and to serve as officers of the COP, the CMP and their subsidiary bodies, and as officers of any sessional bodies, where applicable.¹

Observer States to the Convention

States that are not Parties to the Convention are not required to provide their representatives with credentials.
