În perioada 4 - 6 iunie a.c. urmează să se desfășoare la Paris prima parte a celei de-a 53-a sesiuni ordinare a Adunării Uniunii Europei Occidentale (AUEO).

Pe ordinea de zi a reuniunii figurează: raportul anual al Consiliului UEO; precum și rapoartele privind: Forțele terestre europene în operațiunile externe; Rolul forțelor europene în misiunile NATO din Afganistan; Securitatea în Nordul Îndepărtat; UE și securitatea în Sud-Estul Europei; Agenția Europeană de apărare; Controlul parlamentar al operațiunilor militare internaționale; Stabilitatea și securitatea în Europa.

Domnul deputat Ștefan Glăvan (PC), președintele Comisiei de politică externă a primit invitația de a participa în calitate de observator oficial la lucrările sesiunii AUEO de la Paris.

Propunem:

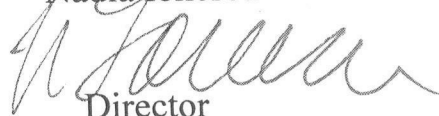
- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Ștefan Glăvan la acțiunea menționată;

- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă cat. a-II-a, 100%, pentru 4 ½ zile, drepturi de cazare, plafon B pentru 4 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;

- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.
