Bundestag-ul german va organiza, la Berlin, în perioada 29-30 aprilie 2007, conferința președinților Comisiilor pentru finanțe din parlamentele statelor membre ale Uniunii Europene (UE), Parlamentul European și parlamentele țărilor candidate.

Conferința are ca temă „Întâmpinarea provocărilor datorate schimbărilor demografice în UE – asigurarea durabilității finanțelor publice și a stabilității piețelor financiare pentru viitor”.

Propunem:

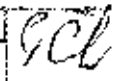
- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Mihai Nicolae Tănăsescu la această acțiune;
