Acțiunea are caracter neparlamentar conf. art. 3, alin a. al HBP nr. 1/2003.

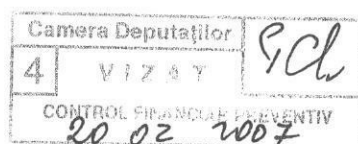
Propunem:
