MEMORANDUM INTERN

Către: domnul Mihai Ungurianu, Secretar general adjunct al Camerei Deputaților

Tema: Reuniunea comemorativă la nivel înalt dedicată sesiunii speciale consacrate copiilor (New York, 11 - 12 decembrie 2007)

Adunarea Generală a ONU organizează, în perioada 11-12 decembrie 2007, la New York, reuniunea plenară la nivel înalt dedicată continuării demersurilor inițiate de sesiunea specială consacrată copiilor, din anul 2002.

Uniunea Interparlamentară (UIP), în calitate sa de observator la ONU, cooperează îndeaproape cu Națiunile Unite pentru soluționarea problemelor majore, de interes general. Asigurarea condițiilor sănătoase de creștere și educație a copiilor, precum și protejarea acestora împotriva abuzurilor constituie priorități pe agenda de lucru a UIP și a Națiunilor Unite.

Având în vedere importanța tematicii abordate, UIP invită parlamentele membre să participe la această reuniune la nivel înalt, care oferă parlamentarilor implicați în mod direct în activitățile legate de rezolvarea aspectelor critice din viața copiilor, șansa cooperării și organizării în demersurile parlamentare care vizează îmbunătățirea acestor aspecte.

Agenda de lucru a reuniunii comemorative cuprinde o sesiune plenară și două mese rotunde tematice, care vor aborda subiecte referitoare la promovarea unei vieți sănătoase - combaterea SIDA și accesul la o educație universală de calitate - element cheie în realizarea Obiectivelor de Dezvoltare ale Mileniului și în protejarea împotriva abuzului, exploatării și violenței la adresa copiilor.

Din partea Camerei Deputaților urmează să participe la această reuniune, doamna deputată Doina Micșunica Drețcanu (PSD), membră a Comitetului Director al Grupului Român al Uniunii Interparlamentare, secretară a Subcomisiei pentru egalitatea de șanse pentru copii din cadrul Comisiei pentru egalitatea de șanse pentru femei și bărbați.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar, conform art. 3, lit. d din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputate Doina Micșunica Drețcanu la această reuniune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București – Paris – New York – București, cu plecare în data de 9 decembrie 2007, ora 07:00 (DL 8485) și întoarcere în data de 14 decembrie 2007, ora 09:50 (DL 134);
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 5 ½ zile, cazare plafon B, pentru 4 nopți și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

to the outcome of the special session on children**

Madam President,
Mr. President,

Children issues are high on the agenda of both the Inter-parliamentary Union and the United Nations. We are pleased to inform you that the United Nations General Assembly is organizing a commemorative high-level plenary meeting devoted to the follow-up to the outcome of the Special Session on Children (2002), which will be taking place on 11 and 12 December 2007, in New York.

The General Assembly agreed that the commemorative meeting will comprise plenary meetings and two thematic round tables, which will be dedicated to promoting healthy lives and combating HIV/AIDS and providing universal quality education as key to achieving the Millennium Development Goals as the first line of protection against abuse, exploitation and violence against children.

I would therefore like to encourage members of parliament who work on children related issues, in their respective parliaments, to attend the high-level debate by joining their national delegations. Should you wish to send a delegation to attend the plenary meeting, the IPU New York Office will gladly provide more background information.

I believe that the high-level plenary meeting represents an ideal opportunity for us to continue

Excellency,

Further to my letter of 1 October 2007 and in keeping with the mandate given to me by General Assembly resolution 61/272 of 29 June 2007, I would like to update you on preparations for the commemorative high-level plenary meeting devoted to the follow-up to the outcome of the Special Session on Children, scheduled to take place on 11 and 12 December 2007.

As you will recall, the General Assembly agreed that the commemorative meeting will comprise plenary meetings and two thematic round tables. A draft programme of the commemorative meeting is attached herewith for your information.

The list of speakers for the plenary meetings will be open as of today, Friday, 9 November 2007. Delegations wishing to inscribe should contact the General Assembly Affairs Branch at 1-212-963-5063. To enable the maximum participation, statements in plenary should not exceed seven minutes.

Regarding the round tables, I would like to propose that they address the following themes from the final document of the special session of the General Assembly on children, entitled "A World Fit for Children" (resolution S-27/2, annex):

- 1) Promoting healthy lives and combating HIV/AIDS.
- 2) Providing universal quality education as key to achieving the Millennium Development Goals and as the first line of protection against abuse, exploitation and violence against children.

Delegations are invited to focus their discussion, during the round tables, on one or more of the cross-cutting themes from the document "A World Fit for Children": ensuring child participation, mobilizing resources, gender equality, and sustainability.

In terms of the format of the round tables, they will each have two Co-chairs selected from among delegates represented at the highest possible level with due regard given to gender balance and equitable geographical representation. I therefore invite Member States to indicate their interest to me by 19 November 2007.

Also, I would encourage a flexible and dynamic flow of discussion among all participants in the round tables, including non-governmental organizations and children. Hence there will be no established list of speakers and interventions will be limited to a maximum of three minutes.

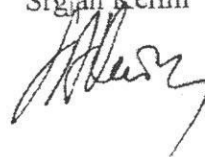
All Members States are invited to participate in either round table. Other participants will include non-governmental organizations and children agreed upon by the General Assembly on 18 October 2007 (decision 62/508). I should point out that the girl and the boy expected to address the closing plenary meeting will be chosen in the Children's Forum.

I wish to thank Ambassador Maria Luiza Ribeiro Viotti, Permanent Representative of Brazil, who has agreed to be the facilitator for the consultations on the outcome document to be adopted by the commemorative high-level plenary meeting.

Finally, I would like to reiterate my invitation to Member States to participate at the highest possible level in the commemorative high-level plenary meeting and to include children and young people in their official delegations.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
