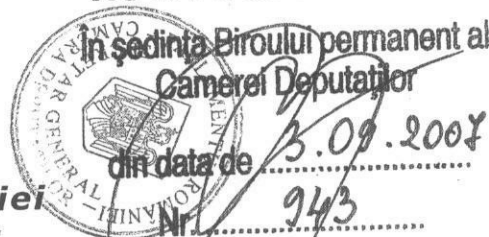

Tema: Participarea la cel de-al 29-lea forum anual al Parlamentarilor pentru Acțiune Globală (PGA) cu tema "Sărăcia și șomajul - cauza migrației".

Abuja, Nigeria, 12-13 noiembrie 2007

Domnul senator Alain Destexhe, președintele Parlamentarilor pentru Acțiune Globală (PGA) a adresat domnului Bogdan Olteanu, președintele Camerei Deputaților, invitația ca membri ai Parlamentului României să participe la cel de-al 29-lea forum anual al PGA, care va avea loc la Abuja, Nigeria, în perioada 12-13 noiembrie 2007.

Forumul va fi găzduit de rețeaua Parlamentarii pentru Acțiune Globală în Parlamentul Național din Nigeria.

Organizația Parlamentarii pentru Acțiune Globală - PGA- este o organizație interparlamentară internațională, înființată în 1978, ce reunește lideri politici din peste 105 state din întreaga lume.

Reuniunea va dezbate ca temă principală „Sărăcia și șomajul - cauza migrației”, reflectând astfel interesul PGA de a supune atenției internaționale una din problemele majore ale lumii contemporane.

Organizatorii au anunțat termenul limită de înregistrare a participanților, respectiv data de 15 septembrie 2007.

Camera Deputaților a fost reprezentată la reuniunile organizate anterior de PGA de membri ai Comisiei pentru administrație publică, amenajarea teritoriului și echilibru ecologic.

Astfel în 2004, vicepreședintele Comisiei (fostul deputat Liviu Bara - PSD) a participat la seminarul cu tema „etică și responsabilitate parlamentară”, care a avut loc la Varșovia, în perioada 26-28 aprilie 2004.

Dear President Olteanu,

We have the honour of writing this letter on behalf of Parliamentarians for Global Action (PGA) to invite an official Delegation of Parliamentarians from Romania to the **29th PGA Annual Forum**. The Forum will take place in the Nigerian Parliament in Abuja, Nigeria from November 12-13, 2007 and will be graciously hosted by the PGA Nigeria National Parliamentary Group.

Founded thirty years ago, Parliamentarians for Global Action (PGA) is an organization which mobilizes parliamentarians to realize the goals of peace, democracy, the rule of law, and sustainable development. The organization currently consists of a network of over 1,300 legislators from 112 countries, drawn from all regions of the world.

The Annual Forum is the focal point of PGA's yearly activities, and this year's theme of *Poverty and Unemployment: The Root Causes of Migration* reflects the vocation of PGA to address issues of international concern that no single country alone may be able to effectively tackle and resolve. Former UN Secretary-General Kofi Annan stated in 2006 that "All countries – whether countries of origin, transit or destination – are affected by international migration. Managing this migration for the benefit of all has become one of the great challenges of our age." Migration can both cause and be caused by poverty and unemployment. Likewise, poverty can be alleviated as well as exacerbated by population flows. While generalizations cannot be readily made, it is probable that the impact of migration on poverty, and of poverty on migration, varies by level of development of the area under consideration. In some parts of the world and under certain conditions, poverty may be a root cause of migration, whereas in other countries, under different conditions, the poor will frequently be the last to move. Similarly, in some areas, migration may be an escape route out of poverty while in others it contributes to an extension of poverty.

As an international organization, PGA has involved itself increasingly in the area of international migration and development, in particular over the past 2 years. The 27th Annual Forum in Dublin, Ireland focussed specifically on *Migration, Immigration & Integration*. PGA also participated in the *High Level Dialogue on Migration and International Development* at the United Nations in September 2006 and the aforementioned theme of

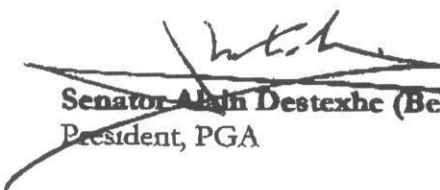

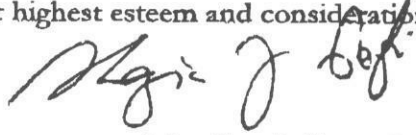
the upcoming 29th PGA Annual Forum in Nigeria in November 2007 is a testimony to the priority we attach to this area of global concern.

The 29th Annual Forum is inviting members of approximately 100 Parliaments from around the world, as well as select governmental and inter-governmental officials, civil society representatives and academics to contribute to this uniquely important gathering.

We therefore look forward to the participation of an official Parliamentary Delegation from Romania in this important international conference, which it is hoped will lead to a greater parliamentary mobilization to address the complex and multifaceted challenges resulting from contemporary trans-national migration flows. A concrete Plan of Action will be adopted by the Participants at the conclusion to the Annual Forum to ensure that momentum generated by the Forum is harnessed into actual follow-on initiatives/activities by the Participants upon return to their respective Parliaments. I would kindly ask that you notify the PGA Secretariat in New York [Mr. Brian Kett (Executive Officer) at brian.kett@pgaction.org] **before September 15, 2007** to confirm the participation of an official Delegation from the Parliament of Romania in PGA's 29th Annual Forum.
