Comisiei politice a Adunării Uniunii Europene Occidentale (AUEO).

În programul vizitei sunt prevăzute întâlniri cu reprezentanți ai guvernului și
ai Parlamentului azer, participarea la o masă rotundă privind securitatea
energetică, vizitarea unei unități militare, precum și a unui terminal de petrol și
gaze de la Marea Caspică.

La acțiunea de la Baku urmează să participe domnul deputat **Alexandru
Ungureanu (PSD)**, membru al Comisiei politice a Adunării UEO și domnul Daniel
Dulca, secretarul delegației.

1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.**

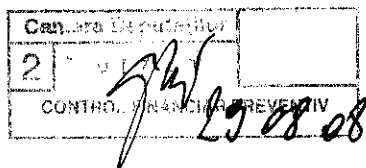
Propunem:
