**Tema: Participarea la cea de-a 19-a sesiune anuală a Forumului
Crans Montana (Monaco, 26-29 iunie 2008) și la Seminarul
internațional privind "Integrarea Balcanilor de Vest în structurile
euro-atlantice" (Hydra, Grecia, 3-5 iulie 2008)**

În perioada 26-29 iunie 2008, la Monaco, va avea loc cea de-a 19-a sesiune anuală a Forumului Crans Montana (**art.3, alin. e al HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007**).

Creat în 1989, Forumul Crans Montana a devenit un loc de întâlnire la care iau parte oameni politici, reprezentanță ai organizațiilor internaționale și a lumii de afaceri pentru schimburi de opinii și idei cu privire la problemele actuale ale relațiilor internaționale.

Organizatorii au adresat domnului deputat Adrian Năstase invitația de a participa la lucrările Forumului, urmând să susțină o alocuțiune la reuniunea de deschidere a Forumului precum și o prezentare în cadrul reuniunii cu tema „Dialogul între civilizații în Mediterana”.

Domnul deputat Adrian Năstase a fost, de asemenea, invitat la Seminarul internațional cu tema „Integrarea Balcanilor de Vest în structurile euro-atlantice”, organizat de Institutul de Relații Internaționale și Universitatea Pantelion din Atena, în perioada 3-5 iulie 2008, în Insula

Hydra (**art. 5, alin. b al HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007**).

La Seminar au fost invitați înalți oficiali și personalități ale lumii academice.

Organizatorii au solicitat domnului deputat o prezentare în cadrul sesiunii cu tema „Identități naționale și minorități”.

Cheltuielile de transport internațional și cazare la Hydra vor fi suportate de organizatori.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Adrian Năstase la acțiunile menționate;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Munchen-Nisa-Zurich-Atena-București, cu plecare în ziua de 25 iunie 2008, ora 13.10 (LH 3421), și întoarcere în ziua de 6 iulie 2008, ora 18.30 (A3 962);
- să se suporte din avansul spre decontare cheltuielile de transport pe ruta Nisa-Monte Carlo și retur;
- să se acorde domnului deputat Adrian Năstase drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 5 zile, cazare plafon B, pentru 5 nopți (pentru acțiunea de la Monte Carlo), și avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- pentru data de 1 iulie a.c. domnul deputat Adrian Năstase nu solicită drepturi de cazare și diurnă;
- să se acorde diurnă categoria I, 100% pentru 4 ½ zile (pentru acțiunea de la Hydra, Grecia).
- recalcularea cheltuielilor urmează să se efectueze la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

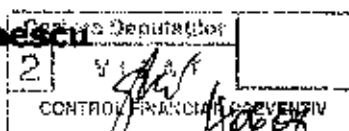

Dear Mr. Nastase,

The Institute of International Relations (I.I.R.), affiliated with Panteion University, Athens, Greece, in cooperation with the Hellenic Observatory of the London School of Economics and the Center of Southeast European Studies of the University of Oxford is organizing, from July 3 through 5, 2008, its International Summer Seminar. The theme of this year's Seminar is: *The Integration of Western Balkans into the Euroatlantic Structures*. The Seminar will take place at Hydra Island (Museum of Hydra-Historical Archives).

In the midst of transition, the Western Balkans entered the 21st century more than a little battered – socially, politically and economically. 2008 is going to present further challenges for the Western Balkans; challenges that are related not only to preparations of candidate countries and their gradual integration into the Euro-Atlantic structures, but also to the consequences of the recent declaration of independence of Kosovo. In a highly complex regional environment – with third parties such as the U.S. and Russia making their presence ever more strongly felt, with many extra-regional states pursuing geopolitical and geneconomic interests, and with energy emerging as a key bargaining chip – the variables dwarf the constants.

At the beginning of 2008 new realities that must be taken into account by all the players in the region emerged. Given the new state of affairs that is taking shape, is integration of the Western Balkans into the Euro-Atlantic structures feasible bearing in mind that Brussels specifies regional cooperation as a prerequisite? What is the future of this region when it is under pressure to accommodate the strategic interests of third countries that in some cases seem more powerful than those of the EU? How can we effectively pursue democracy promotion in a region where security and peace have become the supreme concerns? All these issues and many others will be explored at the International Summer Workshop on the Island of Hydra.

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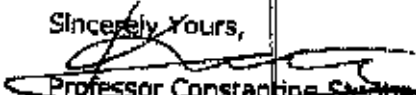
