- deplasarea să se facă pe ruta București-Budapesta și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 24 aprilie 2008, ora 6.10, (MA 857) și întoarcere în ziua de 27 aprilie, ora 01.25 (MA 856);

- să se acorde cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți, diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 3 zile, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară, recalcularea drepturilor urmând a se face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

PROGRAM

Theme of the Conference:

While parliamentary democracy as an institution is gaining acceptance all over the world, national parliaments, as well as the European Parliament, are receiving sharp criticism with increasing frequency. Varying from country to country and time to time, the tendency is that the social acceptance and authority of the parliaments are changing for the worse. Although national Parliaments and MPs have always been a favourite subject of the press, these days they receive more and more negative publicity as far as even reaching the critical limit. Constitutional elements and democratic parties are often influenced and led to this direction by the harsh rules of political rivalry. The debates bearing on the MPs' so-called privileges are more and more unmanageable. All these trends can be observed mainly in the countries that acceded to the European Union lately or in the countries outside the union, but similar phenomena can be observed in Western and Southern Europe, too. Globalization and integration diminish the possibilities of the national governments and parliaments although their responsibilities and the expectations of the electors are unchanged or even increase. The question arises, whether these phenomena that are gaining ground in the past decades can be compared to the depression in parliamentary democracy of the first half of the 20th century, or is this only a disorder due to the changes that are amplified by the revolution in the media and information technology?

The Hungarian Committee on Immunities has been organizing workshop discussions for several years, as well as ordering critical essays on the social and public status of the MPs. Institutionalized European cooperation in this field can be deemed justifiable according to our international exchange of experiences.

We are planning to issue the lectures of this conference in a publication, and they will also be available on the site of the Committee, as well.
