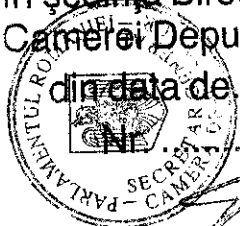

Tema: Participarea la cel de-al 9-lea Summit al președinților grupurilor parlamentare PPE-ED din țările membre ale Uniunii Europene (Bruxelles, 13-14 octombrie 2008)

În perioada 13-14 octombrie a.c., se va desfășura, la Bruxelles, cel de-al 9-lea Summit al președinților grupurilor parlamentare PPE-ED din țările membre ale Uniunii Europene.

În deschidere vor lua cuvântul domnul Joseph Daul, președintele Grupului PPE-ED din Parlamentul European și domnul José Manuel Durao Barroso, președintele Comisiei Europene. Dezbaterile se vor concentra asupra următoarelor teme: campania electorală din 2009 pentru Parlamentul European, cooperarea interparlamentară până la ratificarea Tratatului de la Lisabona și politica externă comună privind energia.

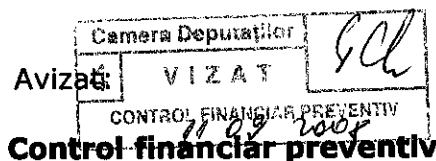
La acest summit a fost invitat să participe domnul deputat Cristian Rădulescu, liderul Grupului parlamentar al PD-L.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, alin.c. al HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea la această acțiune a domnului deputat Cristian Rădulescu;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta **București-Bruxelles și retur**, cu plecare în 12 octombrie 2008, ora 07:20 (RO 371) și întoarcere în 15 octombrie 2008, ora 14:05 (RO 372) conform traseului alăturat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 3 ½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți (noaptea din data de 13 octombrie este suportată de organizatori) și avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

We have pleasure in informing you that the 9th Summit of Chairmen of EPP-ED Parliamentary Groups in National Parliaments of the European Union will take place in Brussels on 13 and 14 October 2008.
