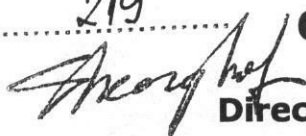

Tema: Participarea la reuniunea Subcomisiei pentru probleme de criminalitate și combaterea terorismului a Comisiei pentru probleme juridice și drepturile omului din cadrul APCE (Atena, 28-29 martie 2008)

În perioada 28-29 martie 2008, la Atena, vor avea loc lucrările Subcomisiei pentru probleme de criminalitate și combaterea terorismului a Comisiei pentru probleme juridice și drepturile omului din cadrul Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (APCE), din care face parte domnul deputat Mihai Tudose, membru al Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE.

Pe agenda Subcomisiei figurează, în prima zi a lucrărilor, participarea la Conferința privind „Măsuri anti-teroriste și drepturile omului”, în deschiderea căreia va susține o alocuțiune domnul Karolos Papoulias, Președintele Republicii Elene. Sesiunile de discuții sunt structurate în mai multe paneele sub următoarele titluri: „Interpretări în afara legii și detenții secrete în Europa”, „Consiliul de Securitate al ONU și listele negre al Uniunii Europene”. În cea de a doua zi a lucrărilor, membrii Subcomisiei au prevăzute spre dezbateră o serie de rapoarte precum: „Măsuri anti-teroriste și drepturile omului în zona Caucazului de Nord”, „Respectul pentru drepturile omului în lupta împotriva terorismului: perspective de viitor”.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Mihai Tudose, membru al Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE, la acțiunea menționată;

- deplasarea să se facă cu avionul pe ruta București – Atena și retur, cu plecare în data de 27.03.2008, ora 10.40 (A3 961) și întoarcere în data de 30.03.2008, ora 18.30 (A3 962), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100 %, pentru 3 1/2 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 3 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

VENUE OF THE MEETINGS

The **Conference** is organised jointly with the Marangopoulos Foundation for Human Rights on **Friday 28 mars morning** and will be held at the Auditorium "Drakopoulou", Central Building of Athens University, Panepistimiou 30 street, Athens, Greece (Tel: + 210 36 89 696; Fax: + 210 36 89 702; Secretariat mobile: +33 (0)6 62 27 65 23 (meeting day only)).

The **meeting of the Sub-Committee on Friday 28 March afternoon** will be held in the meeting room of the Amalia Hotel, Amalias 10 street, Athens, Greece (Tel: + 33 210 32 37 300; Fax: + 33 210 32 37 309; Secretariat mobile: +33 (0)6 62 27 65 23 (meeting day only)).

WORKING LANGUAGES

Interpretation between English and French (the two official languages of the Council of Europe) will be provided. Interpretation into/from Greek will be provided on the morning of Friday 28 March only.

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

Participants are advised to use public transportation between the airport and hotels and between hotels and the meeting place, if necessary.

By metro (line 3): The duration of the journey airport - city centre is approximately 36 minutes. Arrival: Syntagma Square (see appended map). Fare: 6 €. There is a departure every 20 minutes.

By bus (line E 95): The duration of the journey is approximately 1 hour. There is a departure every 20 / 30 minutes. Arrival: Syntagma Square. Fare: 3.20 €

By taxi: It will take you about 30-40 minutes to get from the airport to the city centre. Fare: 35 to 40 €.

ACCOMMODATION

Hotels (all within walking distance of the meeting places) have been proposed by the Marangopoulos Foundation and the Greek Parliament (see attached list). Participants are kindly requested to make their reservations **themselves directly** with the hotel of their choice as soon as possible **because no block-booking has been made.**

VISAS
