**Tema: Participarea la "Reuniunea de toamnă 2008" a Adunării

(18-21 septembrie 2008, Toronto, Canada).**

Adunarea Parlamentară a OSCE (AP OSCE) și Parlamentul Canadei au adresat delegațiilor naționale membre, inclusiv Delegației Parlamentului României la AP OSCE, precum și partenerilor mediteraneeni pentru cooperare, observatorilor oficiali și partenerilor pentru cooperare ai AP OSCE, invitația de a participa la "Reuniunea de toamnă 2008" a AP OSCE organizată în perioada 18-21 septembrie 2008.

Reuniunea este convocată în conformitate cu art. 13 din Regulamentul AP OSCE și include următoarele puncte principale în agenda preliminară:

- conferința cu tema "OSCE într-o lume deschisă: comerț, securitate și migrație";
- reuniunea Comisiei permanente a AP OSCE;
- lucrările Forumului Mediteranean al Adunării.

Potrivit practicii, din rațiuni organizatorice, confirmările de participare sunt așteptate cât mai repede.

Sunt propuși pentru a participa, din partea Camerei Deputaților, membrii Delegației Parlamentului României la AP OSCE și secretarul Delegației, astfel: domnii deputați Cristian Rădulescu - președintele Delegației (PD-L), Vladimir Mircea Fârșirotu (PRM) și Attila Kovács (UDMR), doamna deputată Rodica Nassar (PSD), precum și domnul consilier Mario Ruse.

Propunem:

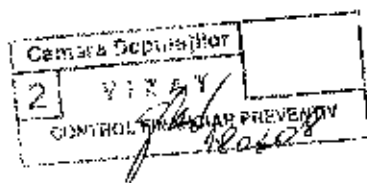

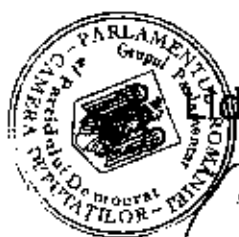

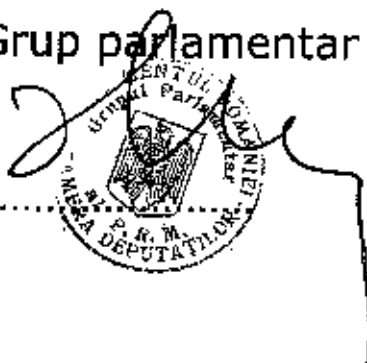

CUSTOMS AND ENTRY PROCEDURES

Because the event is hosted by the Parliament of Canada, the delegates who require a temporary resident visa will not have to pay the temporary resident visa application fee (as per 296(2)(e)(i) of the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Regulations*). Delegates must clearly state that they are attending the OSCE Parliamentary Assembly on their application form.

To learn about the current visa and passport requirements, the official Web site for Citizenship and Immigration Canada is www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/index.asp. Canadian Embassies or High Commissions may also be of assistance.

DIPLOMATIC REPRESENTATION

All Embassies and High Commissions in Canada will be notified of the meetings, and will receive a copy of the program.

Participants wishing to reach their diplomatic representatives in Canada can consult the Department of Foreign Affairs at Web site at www.international.gc.ca.

INSURANCE

Please obtain health and travel insurance before coming to Canada. Coverage should include medical care obtained in community health facilities such as hospitals and clinics as well as physician's care. It is also important that participants with prescribed medications bring a copy of their prescriptions with them as well as the medications themselves.

TRANSPORTATION

The Canadian Secretariat will provide ground transportation by coach for all participants arriving and departing through Toronto Pearson International Airport (YYZ). It is therefore important that travel details be forwarded to the Canadian Secretariat for each traveller.

The Toronto Pearson International Airport is situated 50 km from Toronto. Participants arriving at the Toronto airport on Tuesday, September 16 and Wednesday, September 17 will be offered shuttle service to the Fairmont Royal York Hotel with the compliments of the Canadian delegation. On Saturday, September 20, after meetings, Sunday, September 21, and on Monday, September 22, a shuttle service will be available from the hotel to the airport.

Participants wishing to arrive and depart other days are invited to organise their own transfer. Airport Express runs a 24-hour shuttle service for a (current rate) fee of \$16.45 Canadian dollars per person one way, every 20 minutes between the airport and the downtown core, and stops at the Fairmont Royal York Hotel. The trip takes approximately 45 minutes. Go to www.torontoairportexpress.com to book. Car service may be arranged through the hotel concierge. As of April 2007, a taxi to the downtown core is about \$46.00 plus tip.

Transportation will be provided for official events and excursions. Please note that bus service will be available to allow delegates to visit Niagara Falls and still take their flights scheduled on the excursion day, Sunday, September 21. For further information, please see the Travel and Excursion Form on the Conference Web site at www.oscepa-aposce.ca.

REGISTRATION

Upon arrival, delegates are requested to register at the Conference Desk on the conference level of the Fairmont Royal York Hotel near the Concert Hall on Wednesday, September 17 from 14:00 to 21:00 or on Thursday, September 18 from 08:00.

Participants may be required to show an official identification (passport or identity card) when registering.

All participants will be required to wear identity badges to attend meetings and social events, as well as when using transportation services offered by the conference.

INTERPRETATION

DRESS

CURRENCY

The Canadian currency is the Canadian dollar (CAN\$). Most major credit cards are widely accepted. Moreover, ATMs (Automated Teller Machines) are available throughout the city, and banks and the hotel can provide exchange services.

TELEPHONES/ELECTRICITY SERVICE

Mobile telephones work on the North American standard. North American electric service is 110/220 service. Adaptors are not readily available and will be required for any European equipment.

TIPPING

A 15% tip on the pre-tax bill is a standard expression of appreciation when dining out if you are happy with the service. Please note that some restaurants will automatically add a gratuity of 15-20% when

serving large groups, so be sure to check your bill. A similar percentage is standard for haircuts, shoe shines, taxis and other such services.

WEATHER

The weather in Toronto is usually quite pleasant this time of the year with average day-time high temperatures of around 20°C. Temperatures in Niagara Falls and at Niagara-on-the-Lake are generally cooler.

VISITING CANADA

In 2008, Québec City will celebrate the 400th Anniversary of its founding, in 1608. The anniversary is a time when people from all over Canada and around the world will gather to celebrate 400 years of history, culture and encounters. 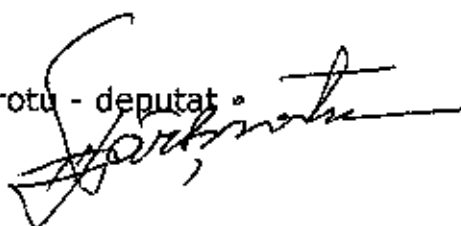
