Biroul Permanent al Camerei Deputaților, prin Memorandumul intern nr.62a/422 din 04.03.2008 a aprobat participarea unui reprezentant al Camerei Deputaților la cea de a VII-a Conferință a Președinților de parlamente din statele participante la Procesul de Cooperare din Europa de Sud-Est. Grupul parlamentar al PSD l-a desemnat pe domnul deputat Adrian Năstase să participe la această acțiune.

- domnul deputat Adrian Năstase să efectueze deplasarea pe ruta București-Istanbul-Bahrain-Istanbul-Moscova-Sofia-București cu plecare pe data de 08 aprilie 2008, ora 10.45, zbor TK 1444, și întoarcere pe data de 15 aprilie 2008, ora 19.20, zbor RO 292;
- să se acorde domnului deputat Adrian Năstase:
 - pentru Manama; drepturi de cazare plafon A, pentru 1 noapte la hotelul propus de organizatori și la prețul ofertat, drepturi de diurnă categoria a I-a, 100%, pentru 2 zile,
 - pentru Moscova; drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 50%, pentru 3 zile precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară,
 - pentru Sofia; drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 2 1/2 zile precum și un avans de 50 % cu decontare ulterioară,
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

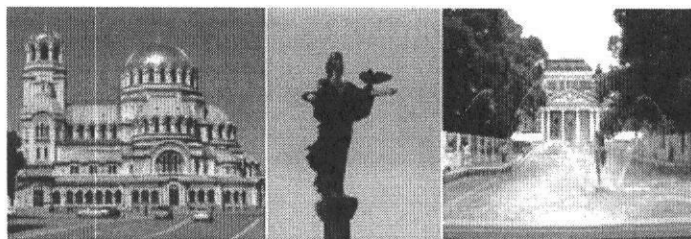
