Tema: Marcarea Zilei Internaționale a Democrației de către Parlamentul României - 15 septembrie 2008

Printr-o scrisoare adresată domnului Bogdan Olteanu, Președintele Camerei Deputaților, domnul Ferdinando Casini, Președintele Uniunii Interparlamentare, a avansat propunerea de a fi organizate acțiuni, la nivelul instituției parlamentare, care să marcheze ziua de 15 septembrie ca Zi Internațională a Democrației.

15 septembrie a fost stabilită ca Zi Internațională a Democrației de către Adunarea Generală a Națiunilor Unite, la sfârșitul anului 2007. Importanța simbolică a datei de 15 septembrie este legată de momentul istoric al adoptării de către Uniunea Interparlamentară, a Declarației Universale privind Democrația, cu ocazia celei de-a 161-a sesiuni, din septembrie 1997.

Parlamentele, ca instituții fundamentale ale democrației, în care sunt reprezentate toate componentele societății și care au puterea și mijloacele necesare pentru a exprima voința poporului prin adoptarea legislației și controlul guvernării, sunt încurajate de Uniunea Interparlamentară să marcheze ziua de 15 septembrie prin acțiuni care să atragă atenția asupra locului parlamentului în sistemele democratice.

Propunem:

Birourile Permanente ale Camerei Deputaților și Senatului să analizeze și să dispună cu privire la marcarea Zilei Internaționale a Democrației prin acțiuni precum:

- prezentarea în plen a unor declarații de către reprezentanții grupurilor politice;
- organizarea zilei porților deschise pentru elevi, studenți și cetățeni interesați, de către Direcția de relații publice și Centrul Internațional de Conferinței;
- postarea pe pagina de internet a Camerei Deputaților a Declarației Universale privind Democrația, de către Direcția pentru tehnologia informației și comunicațiilor.

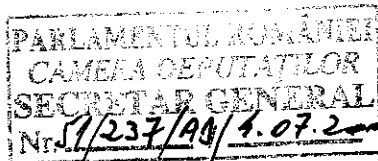

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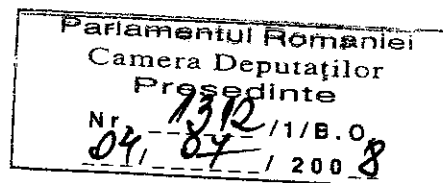

International Day of Democracy - 15 September

Dear Mr. President,

Few would dispute that a strong parliament is a vital sign of a healthy democracy. Parliament is after all the central institution within a democracy through which the will of the people is expressed, laws are passed and government is held to account. While the existence of a parliament may not in itself guarantee democracy, there can be no democracy without a parliament.

That is why we would like to encourage your parliament to mark the first International Day of Democracy this coming 15 September by some activity that could highlight the place of parliament in a democracy.

As you may know, the United Nations General Assembly established late last year this new International Day to celebrate democracy. Highly symbolically, the date coincides with the adoption, in September 1997, of the IPU Universal Declaration on Democracy.

We take the liberty of attaching a Note listing objectives and activities that your parliament may wish to consider when preparing for the day. The Inter-Parliamentary Union is at your disposal to provide documentary and advisory support. For example, we will be pleased to make available several copies of IPU publications on democracy to parliaments planning to celebrate the day.

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PROPOSALS FOR PARLIAMENTS TO CELEBRATE THE FIRST INTERNATIONAL DAY OF DEMOCRACY 15 SEPTEMBER 2008

Objectives:

This day would be an opportunity for parliaments to:

- Emphasize the importance of democracy, what it involves, the challenges it faces as well as the opportunities it offers, and the central responsibility that all parliaments have as the key institution of democracy;
- Examine and discuss how well parliament performs its democratic functions, possibly on the basis of a self-assessment, and identify what steps it may take to strengthen its effectiveness.

Proposed activities:

Parliaments could organize some form of event on democracy on 15 September (or as close thereto as feasible in the light of circumstances). Such an event could take multiple forms such as:

- Day of "open doors" in Parliament, when students and interested citizens could observe the parliamentary proceedings of the day;
- Special debate in parliament focusing on ways of making parliament and the political process more representative, transparent, accessible, accountable and effective, i.e. more democratic;
- National review of progress made in meeting international commitments in the area of democracy and human rights, with a focus on areas for future efforts;
- Reading of the *Universal Declaration on Democracy* and/or adoption of a parliamentary resolution or declaration marking the International Day of Democracy;
- Joint session / video-conference among two or more parliaments, addressing a democracy-related issue of common interest.
