Parlamentul Cehiei organizează, în perioada 27-28 martie 2008, la sediul său din Praga, reuniunea președinților Comisiilor pentru agricultură din parlamentele țărilor membre ale grupului de la Visegrad (V4), România și Bulgaria.

Subiectele abordate în cadrul dezbaterilor vor dezvolta concluziile reuniunii precedente desfășurate la Bratislava, în perioada 2-4 aprilie 2007: nivelul pregătirii Cehiei în domeniul agriculturii, în vederea preluării președinției UE; stadiul dezvoltării agriculturii țării gazdă, după patru ani de la aderarea la UE; evaluarea stadiului reformei politicii agricole comune, din perspectiva țărilor implicate.

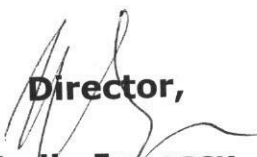

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București – Praga și retur, cu plecare în data de 27 martie 2008, ora 06:50 (OK 805) și întoarcere în data de 29 martie 2008, ora 22:05 (OK 804);
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100% pentru 3 zile și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

Dear Mr. Chairman,

Allow me to take this opportunity to invite you to a meeting of the agricultural committees of the parliaments of the V4 countries, Romania and Bulgaria, which is being organised by the Committee on National Economy, Agriculture and Transport of the Senate of the Parliament of the Czech Republic and the Committee on Agriculture of the Chamber of Deputies of the Parliament of the Czech Republic on the premises of the Parliament of the Czech Republic on 27 and 28 March 2008.

Our aim is to build on the conclusions of our last meeting, which was held in Bratislava on 2 – 4 April 2007.

The current joint agricultural policy is undergoing a number of radical changes which are impacting on the individual countries of Europe in different ways. We have chosen the following topics of discussion for our meeting in March:

- Level of preparation of the Czech Republic for the EU Presidency in the field of agriculture
- Agriculture in the Czech Republic after four years in the EU
- Development of agriculture following the accession to the EU, preparation for checking the status of reform of the Common Agricultural Policy from the perspective of the countries involved.

We are convinced that this discussion of up-to-date European topics will lead to further development of communication between our respective legislative bodies and will be of great benefit to the preparation of the desired changes in the coming period.

Thank you very much for your e-mail.

The information you have is correct. The Czech Parliament will cover the accommodation costs (room and breakfast) for two MPs and one staff member per each parliamentary chamber (in case of the Romanian parliament it means for 2 deputies + 1 staff member from the Chamber of Deputies and for 2 senators + 1 staff member from the Senate).

We will cover this accommodation from 27 - 29 March 2008 (2 nights). In case of an earlier arrival (on 26 March) you will have to pay the accommodation for this one night by yourself. We will need the credit card information (card number, holder's name, date of expiry).
