Tema: Participarea la lucrările Comisiei generale pentru probleme economice a Inițiativei Central-Europene - Dimensiunea Parlamentară (Praga, Republica Cehă, 10-12 iunie 2008).

La reuniunea Adunării Parlamentare a Inițiativei Central-Europene de la Sofia, din 20-22 noiembrie 2007, domnul deputat Bogdan Pascu, președintele Delegației Parlamentului României la Inițiativa Central-Europeană – Dimensiunea Parlamentară (ICE-DP), a fost reales președinte al Comisiei generale pentru probleme economice a ICE-DP.

În baza solicitării Delegației Parlamentului Republicii Cehe la ICE-DP de a organiza și găzdui reuniunea Comisiei generale pentru probleme economice a ICE-DP, președintele Comisiei a convocat această reuniune pentru perioada 10-12 iunie a.c., la Praga.

Proiectul de agendă al reuniunii prevede: o dezbatere pe tema "Viitorul energiei nucleare în Europa", alegeri pentru poziția vacantă de vicepreședinte al Comisiei și o vizită de documentare la obiective relevante în raport cu tema reuniunii.

Potrivit art. 10 din Regulamentul ICE-DP, la reuniune participă de drept membrii Comisiei generale pentru probleme economice a ICE-DP.

Sunt propuși pentru a participa, din partea Camerei Deputaților, domnii deputați Bogdan Pascu - președintele Comisiei și președinte al Delegației Parlamentului României la ICE-DP, și Liviu Câmpanu - membru al Comisiei, precum și secretarul Comisei și al Delegației Parlamentului României la ICE-DP, domnul consilier Mario Ruse.

Deoarece ICE-DP nu dispune de un secretariat propriu, această activitate revine integral secretarului Delegației Parlamentului României la ICE-DP din partea Camerei Deputaților.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar (art. 3, lit. d din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007).

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea la această acțiune a domnilor deputați Bogdan Pascu (PC) și Liviu Câmpanu (PNL), precum și a domnului consilier Mario Ruse.

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București – Praga și retur, astfel:

- cu plecare la 10 iunie a.c., orele 15.15 (zbor OK 803) și întoarcere la 12 aprilie a.c., orele 14.30 (zbor OK 802), pentru domnul deputat Bogdan Pascu;
- cu plecare la 10 iunie a.c., orele 15.15 (zbor OK 803) și întoarcere la 13 aprilie a.c., orele 14.30 (zbor OK 802), pentru domnul deputat Liviu Câmpanu și domnul consilier Mario Ruse.

- să se acorde cazare plafon B, la hotelul recomandat de organizatori, astfel:

- pentru 2 nopți, pentru domnul deputat Bogdan Pascu;
- pentru 3 nopți, pentru domnul deputat Liviu Câmpanu și domnul consilier Mario Ruse.

- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, astfel:

- pentru 2 zile, pentru domnul deputat Bogdan Pascu;
- pentru 3 zile, pentru domnul deputat Liviu Câmpanu și domnul consilier Mario Ruse.

- să se acorde un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară.

- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se efectueze la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

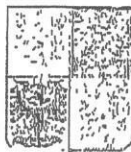

Let me inform you that our delegation agrees with technical requirements set by your side. However, we would like to propose another term for hosting the meeting of the CEI-PD General Committee on Economic Affairs in Prague, namely 11 – 12 June 2008 (June 10 – arrival of participants, June 11 – committee sitting, June 12 – excursion to the nuclear power plant Temelin).

We also suggest the meeting to be monothematic, concentrated on "Future of nuclear energy in Europe" (i.e. we would like to leave out the topic "Security of energy supplies").

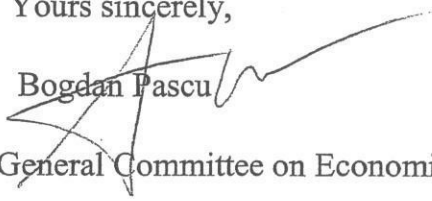

Distinguished colleague,

Following to the proposals submitted by your Delegation on organizing the Meeting of the CEI-PD General Committee on Economic Affairs (GCEA), in Prague, in 2008, and on the two themes to be discussed in the GCEA in 2008, both related to the very opportune theme of energy, **I decided to support the idea of organizing the 2008 GCEA Meeting, in Prague, on the general theme of energy** that is reflecting most of the proposals we received according with the decision adopted during the GCEA last meeting held in Sofia in November 2007.

In this respect, in order to initiate the procedures and to convene the meeting, I need to agree with you on some technical issues and I will kindly introduce you in below the commonly used steps in organizing, in the frame of the CEI-PD, of other previous reunions, including the committee meetings.

1. In order to initiate the procedures, as Chairperson of the GCEA, **I have firstly to receive from you an official letter** through which you, as hosts, will assume to organize this meeting and some other responsibilities as mentioned in below.

Then, based on your letter, as soon as I will receive it, I will send an official notification to all CEI-PD Delegations through which I will convene the meeting and announce them the venue, the period and the draft agenda (including the themes) of the meeting and I will introduce your contacts. Then the organizers (the Czech hosts) will directly provide to the participants the other details in due time (such as the general information, the draft programme, the registration form and hotel reservation forms, deadlines).

Of course, we will have to agree on the draft programme and the period of the meeting.

2. Concerning the agenda of the meeting, it will basically consist in:

- **FIRST DAY:** a short opening session, followed by panels (for the proposed themes on energy) and one short final session for adoption of the resolution:
- **SECOND DAY:** the study-visit (preferable in the first part of the day, thus the participants may decide to leave Prague in the evening of the same day).

3. Concerning the period of the Meeting, **I am proposing you the period of 9-10 April for the GCEA Meeting.** In this respect, the participants may arrive on 8 April (Tuesday) and stay, depending of their wishes, until maximum 11 April (Friday) according with the hotel booking that you will provide.

4. Concerning the responsibilities, services, and logistics:

The costs of the international transportation and the local transportation concerning the airport transfer (at the arrival and departure of the participants), as well as the hotel cost *are fully in the responsibility of the participants*.

The other arrangements related to the programme are assigned to the organizers and are including:

- booking of the hotel rooms for the participants and invitees during the period they we will decide together;
- covering of the costs for: lunch and dinner during the first day and lunch of the second day, as well as coffees during the breaks; the internal transportation at all activities included in the programme of the reunion (except the airport transfer as mentioned);
- organizing and covering of the expenses for the study-visit during the second day of the meeting (the visit must include at least one objective related to the theme of energy);
- providing (free of charge) the necessary logistics for the works of the meeting, including the venue;
- providing expertise during the meeting (including: invitees and/or own MPs that will have presentations on the specialized energy themes you proposed, having in view that the presence of foreign experts is difficult to be guaranteed; contributing with some proposals drafted in English for the draft Resolution of the meeting, etc).

The Secretariat of the meeting will be a mixed one (Romanian and Czech) and we will cooperate in drafting a resolution for this meeting.

Depending on the context, we may also consider the need of a short (one-day) preparatory meeting, in Prague, before mid-March 2008 (with the participation of the Chairperson and, by the case, of the Secretary of the Committee).

If you agree on these proposals, please kindly provide me as soon as possible the mentioned letter, in order to proceed to initiate the procedures.
