**Tema: Participarea la cel de-al 7-lea Congres privind securitatea și
apărarea europeană, Berlin, (10-11 noiembrie 2008)**

În zilele de 10 și 11 noiembrie 2008 urmează să se desfășoare la Berlin cel de-al 7-lea Congres privind securitatea și apărarea europeană având ca temă "2008:Foaia de parcurs către o Uniune de Securitate și Apărare".

Pe ordinea de zi a congresului figurează teme de actualitate precum: extinderea Uniunii Europene și viitorul Kosovo, strategia maritimă de securitate europeană, rolul Parlamentelor în apărarea și securitatea europeană, implicații politice și strategice în cooperarea transatlantică, provocări viitoare pentru industria de securitate și apărare, Politica Europeană de Vecinătate.

Propunem:

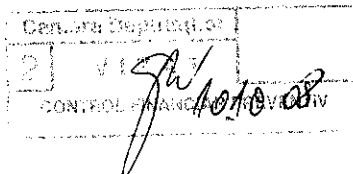
- să se aprobe participarea delegației parlamentare române la acțiunea de la Berlin;

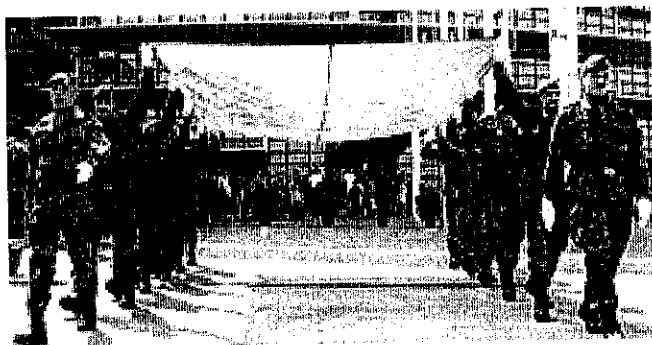

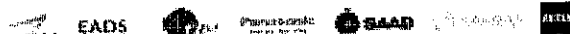
