Tema: Participarea la seminarul AP NATO privind securitatea în zona Mării Caspice (Baku, 6 - 8 martie 2008)

Adunarea parlamentară a NATO organizează, în colaborare cu Parlamentul Republicii Azerbaijan, un seminar cu tema „Securitatea în regiunea Mării Caspice”, care va avea loc la Baku, în perioada 6-8 martie 2008.

Seminarul, la care vor participa parlamentari din țările membre NATO, din Europa de Est și Caucazul de Sud, precum și reprezentanți ai unor organizații internaționale, va avea următoarele sesiuni de lucru: 1. Securitatea în regiunea Mării Caspice – Puncte de vedere ale țărilor din Caucazul de Sud; 2. Securitatea energetică în regiunea caspică; 3. Relațiile între Occident și Asia Centrală; 4. Securitatea în Asia Centrală – Contextul regional; 5. Asia Centrală și Afganistanul; 6. Securitatea în Asia Centrală – Evoluții pe plan național.

Tudor (PRM), Cristian Valeriu Buzea (PRM) și Cristian Ilie (PD), membri ai delegației parlamentare române la AP NATO.
