Tema: Solicitarea de desfășurare a unui eveniment organizat de Ministerul Sănătății Publice

Ministerul Sănătății Publice, intenționează să organizeze cu ocazia Zilei europene a numărului unic de apel 1-1-2, ce urmează a fi sărbătorită pentru prima dată în toate țările member UE, în data de **6 februarie a.c.**, între orele 10:00 - 16:30, un seminar cu participare internațională.

În acest scop, organizatorii solicită utilizarea în regim de gratuitate a unei săli, din cadrul Palatului Parlamentului, dotată cu echipamentul tehnic aferent, inclusiv instalație de translație simultană, în ziua de 6 februarie a.c.

Propunem alocarea sălii **"Drepturilor Omului"**, dotată cu echipamentul corespunzător.

Menționăm că, în conformitate cu hotărârile succesive ale Biroului Permanent al Camerei Deputaților, referitoare la grila de tarife a Centrului Internațional de Conferințe și acordarea de facilități în funcție de statutul beneficiarului, în cazul Ministerului Sănătății Publice se prevede plata a 50% din chiria sălii, a cheltuielilor administrative și a serviciilor tehnice și administrative aferente.

De asemenea, prin Memorandumul intern nr. 1462 din 17.12.2007, Biroul permanent al Camerei Deputaților a aprobat să "minimizeze, pe cât posibil, volumul de aprobări de gratuități pentru diversele solicitări ce pot apărea în vederea desfășurării de acțiuni".

Supunem analizei și deciziei dumneavoastră solicitarea Ministerului Sănătății Publice.

Context of the seminar:

Mrs Valean, MEP for Romania, concerned by the 112 emergency number problematic, decided to engage in a Europe-wide campaign to raise awareness of the European Parliament and European citizens. This started with the 112 petition and its press conference at the European Parliament, then with the written declaration for an efficient 112, her participation to the European Security and Safety Summit held in June 2007 in Brussels and her parliamentary activity <http://www.valean.eu/tag/112>. She is also the EENA "112 National Champion for Romania" and is now organising a seminar in Bucharest in view of gathering Romanian stakeholders involved in emergency services together with European and world experts.

Objective of the seminar:

- Provide Romanian emergency authorities with a roadmap on how to best tackle the problems and challenges related to the implementation and functioning of the single European number, 112, in Romania
- To benefiting from expertise and best practices from European and the US - international experts.
- Allow all Romanian stakeholders to meet each other, to speak up their position and to engage a real dialogue.

The debate will allow Romanian stakeholders to focus on the problems, benefit from best practices from Europe and around the world, be aware of existing technological solutions and funding opportunities at European level.

The presence of political figures will also allow collaborating to establish future political initiatives and implementations

We believe that the roundtable will pave the way to further initiatives for promoting the importance of the single European number, 112 and the tools for an efficient use of the 112.
