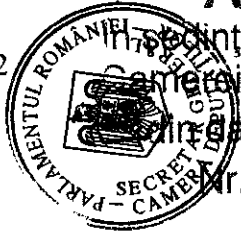
În perioada 30-31 martie 2009, la Valencia, a avut loc reuniunea Comisiei de monitorizare a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (A.P.C.E.), la care a participat domnul deputat Mihai Tudose, membru al Delegației Parlamentului României la A.P.C.E.

Pe ordinea de zi a lucrărilor comisiei au fost supuse spre dezbatere următoarele puncte de vedere privind:

- Serbia: s-a exprimat un punct de vedere din partea coraportorului dl. Gross, privind vizita sa de informare de la Belgrad din 9-10 februarie a.c. și modul în care Serbia își respectă obligațiile și angajamentele ;
- Georgia: s-a exprimat un punct de vedere al coraportorilor privind vizita de informare de la Tbilisi din 25 și 16 martie a.c.;
- Azerbaidjan: a fost examinat avizul Comisiei de la Veneția privind proiectele de amendamente ale Constituției Republicii Azerbaidjan;
- Bosnia-Herțegovina: s-a exprimat un punct de vedere al președintelui privind vizita oficială din Bosnia-Herțegovina din februarie a.c. De asemenea coraportorul M. Cavusoglu, a prezentat punctul său de vedere asupra celui de al 70-lea Seminar Rose-Roth organizat de Adunarea Parlamentară a NATO care a avut loc la Sarajevo în perioada 19-21 martie a.c.;
- Albania: s-a examinat nota privind vizita de informare a coraportorilor care a avut loc la Tirana în perioada 9-11 februarie a.c.;
- Turcia: s-a examinat nota privind vizita de informare a președintelui în Turcia din perioada 24-26 noiembrie 2008. De asemenea comisia a fost informată de către delegația turcă privind alegerile electorale din 29 martie 2009;

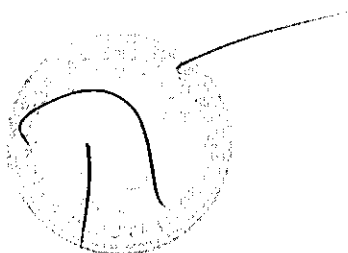
- Macedonia: a avut loc un schimb de păreri privind alegerile prezidențiale din 22 martie 2009;

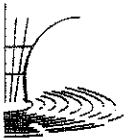

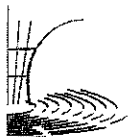
