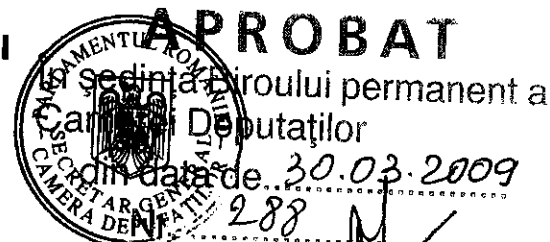

Domnii Lluís Maria De Puig, președintele Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei și domnul Sergey Mironov, președintele Consiliului Adunării Inter-Parlamentare a Comunității Statelor Independente au adresat doamnei Roberta Alma Anastase invitația de participare la lucrările Congresului Ecologic Internațional Nevsky, 14 mai 2009, Sankt Petersburg, iar domnul Sergey Mironov, președintele Consiliului Adunării Inter-parlamentare a Comunității Statelor Independente a transmis invitația de participare la cea de a 32-a Sesiune Plenară a Adunării Inter-Parlamentare a Comunității Statelor Independente.

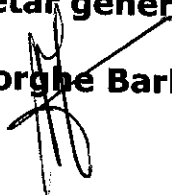
Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit.a și c, din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea reprezentanților Camerei Deputaților la aceste acțiuni;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București-Paris-Sankt Petersburg și retur, cu plecare în data de 13 mai 2009, ora 6.50 (AF 1089) și întoarcere în data de 16 mai 2009, ora 22.55 (AF 1088);
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 4 zile și cazare plafon B, pentru 3 nopți la hotelul recomandat de organizatori, și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative
