Tema: Participarea domnului deputat Adrian Năstase la cea de a treia parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2009 a APCE și la cea de a 20-a Sesiune a Forumului Crans Montana (22-24 iunie 2009, Strasbourg și 24-27 iunie 2009, Bruxelles)

În perioada 22-26 iunie 2009, la Strasbourg, are loc cea de a treia parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2009 a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei, la care participă membrii Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE, din componența căreia face parte și domnul deputat **Adrian Năstase** (PSD+PC), vicepreședinte al Camerei Deputaților.

În perioada 24-27 iunie 2009, domnul vicepreședinte Adrian Năstase este invitat să participe la cea de a 20-a Sesiune a Forumului Crans Montana, de la Bruxelles, dedicată rolului internațional al Uniunii Europene și al strategiilor sale față de Orient, Africa și lumea arabă.

Acțiunile au caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, literele a) și e) din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Adrian Năstase la acțiunile menționate;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Paris-Strasbourg - Bruxelles și retur, cu plecare din București în 21 iunie 2009, ora 9.20 (AF 2789) și întoarcere în 28 iunie 2009, ora 14.05 (RO 372), conform traseului alăturat;

- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 7 1/2 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 7 nopți (3 nopți la Strasbourg, în numerar, întrucât rezervările se efectuează prin intermediul Reprezentanței Permanente a României la Consiliul Europei și 4 nopți la Bruxelles) și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

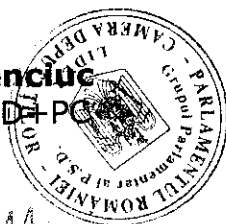
