**Tema: Participarea la cel de-al 60-lea Congres Internațional de Astronautică și la
Reuniunea internațională a parlamentarilor „Spațiul și schimbările
climatice” (Daejeon, Republica Coreea, 11-12 octombrie 2009)**

În zilele de 11 și 12 octombrie 2009, la Daejeon, Republica Coreea, va avea loc **cel de-al 60-lea Congres Internațional de Astronautică**, ale cărui lucrări vor debuta cu **Reuniunea internațională a parlamentarilor** pe tema „**Spațiul și schimbările climatice**”.

În ideea creării unei cooperări mondiale în scopul utilizării călătoriilor spațiale pentru beneficiul umanității, evenimentul oferă o platformă de dialog între reprezentanții parlamentelor lumii și experți în domeniu, care vor prezenta posibilitățile de utilizare a tehnologiilor spațiale actuale sau viitoare în folosul domeniilor cheie de interes global ale umanității, cum sunt: schimbarea climatică, managementul resurselor naturale de hrană, monitorizarea mediului, a securității, etc.

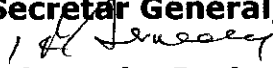
În acest context, reuniunea inaugurală va fi axată pe oferirea informațiilor legate de cele mai recente progrese în cercetarea schimbărilor climatice pentru înțelegerea, analiza și inițierea măsurilor adecvate.

Organizatorii asigură transportul de la/la Seul la Daejeon și asigură mesele în zilele de 11 și 12 octombrie a.c.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, alin e, al HBP 1/2003, modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputat Liana Dumitrescu la acțiunea menționată;
- deplasarea să se facă cu avionul pe ruta București-Frankfurt-Seul și retur, cu plecare în data de 9 octombrie a.c., orele 14:15(LH 3413) și întoarcere în data de 13 octombrie a.c., orele 23:40 (LH 3416), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 2^{1/2} zile, 50% pentru 2 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 3 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară.
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

In the context of developing its vision "A space-faring world co-operating for the benefit of humanity", the International Astronautical Federation (IAF) intends to widen its network to the community of politicians with special focus on Members of Parliaments. In doing this, IAF is offering a well-defined and organised platform for a dialogue with the traditional space community (governmental representatives, agencies, industry, engineers and scientists) on a global scale.

This new initiative is reflecting upon the creation of a group of international parliamentary representatives from various countries of the world. The event would give an opportunity to present, for political stakeholders from governing and non-governing parties alike, the potential of current or future space technologies to deal with key topics of major and global interest. These topics include climate change, food and natural resources management, environmental monitoring, security, and other topics of global relevance.

We are therefore pleased to invite you personally to attend the first meeting which will take place on **Sunday 11 October 2009** in the context of the 60th International Astronautical Congress in Daejeon, Republic of Korea.

The focus topic of this inaugurating meeting will be **climate change**. The one-day programme (see attachment) will be composed of four distinguished speakers who will inform you on current progress in research of climate change and address the use of space technology for the understanding, the analysis and initiation of adequate measures. These will be followed by an exchange of views and statements from participating parliamentarians. We will invite you for a formal Dinner on Sunday 11th October, where you will have the opportunity to meet world leaders of space agencies and industry.

The number of participants will be limited to about 50. The organisers intend to prepare an attractive programme to visit local high technology and space industry and to meet Korean parliamentarians in Seoul. Participants will be furthermore invited as guests of honour to the opening ceremony day of the IAC.

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The IAF and the Local Organising Committee is pleased to offer to all participants a dedicated shuttle service from and to the International Airport as well as local transportation during your stay. Hotel accommodation in the Spapia 5* has been booked in advance. We additionally invite you and accompanying people to both lunch and dinner on Sunday 11th October. Please note that hotel accommodation and travel arrangements to and from Seoul are non-subsidised.

We are looking forward to your participation in this first meeting and to seeing you in Daejeon.
