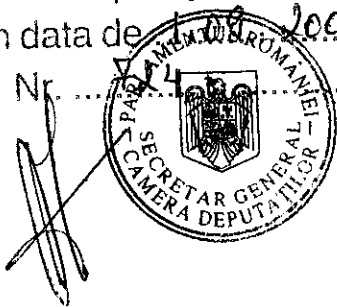

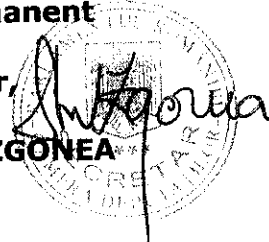

**Tema: Participarea la lucrările celui de al XIX-lea Forum Economic de la
Krynica, Polonia, 9-12 septembrie 2009**

În perioada 9-12 septembrie 2009 va avea loc la Krynica, Polonia, sub egida Institutului pentru Studii Estice, cea de a XIX-a ediție a Forumului Economic cu tema "Dezvoltarea dialogului și cooperării între țările Uniunii Europene și vecinii și partenerii săi".

La această acțiune a fost invitat să participe domnul deputat Aurel Vainer (Grupul parlamentar al minorităților naționale), vicepreședinte al Comisiei pentru politică economică, reformă și privatizare din Camera Deputaților.

Reuniunea va avea în dezbateri teme precum: politicile internaționale și de securitate; sectorul energetic; știința și cultura; Uniunea Europeană și vecinii săi; noua economie; etc.

Forumul Economic va reuni peste 1500 de participanți din Europa, Asia Centrală, SUA și Orientul Mijlociu, printre care, șefi de state, politicieni, oameni de afaceri și academicieni.

Organizatorii suportă toate cheltuielile legate de cazare, mese și transportul pe tronsonul Cracovia-Krynica-Cracovia pentru parlamentarii invitați să participe la această reuniune.

Acțiunea se încadrează în prevederile art.3, lit. e) din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Aurel Vainer la această reuniune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București-Varșovia-Cracovia și retur, cu plecare în data de 9 septembrie a.c., orele 14.35, zbor LO 642 și întoarcere în data de 12 septembrie a.c., orele 13.45, zbor LO 641;
- să se acorde drepturi diurnă categoria a II-a, 50% pentru 3 zile, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se efectueze la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

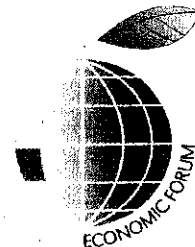
