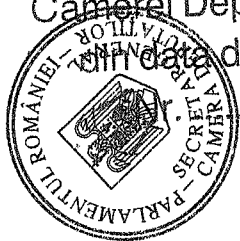

Din partea Delegației parlamentare române la AUEO vor participa doamna deputată **Florina Ruxandra Jipa (PSD+PC)**, supleanta domnului senator Radu Cătălin Mardare, președintele delegației, care nu va putea participa la acțiune, domnul deputat **Edler András György (UDMR)**, precum și domnul Daniel Dulca, secretarul delegației.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, lit.a) din HBP 1/2003 modificată și completată prin HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea delegației parlamentare române la sesiunea de la Paris;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Paris și retur, cu plecare în ziua de 30 noiembrie a.c., ora 13.05 (zbor RO 383) și întoarcere

În ziua de 04 decembrie a.c., orele 16.15 (zbor RO 382), conform traseului anexat;

- să se aprobe drepturi de diurnă cat.a II-a, 100% pentru 4 ½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 4 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;

- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.

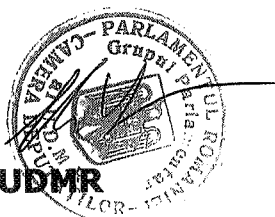
