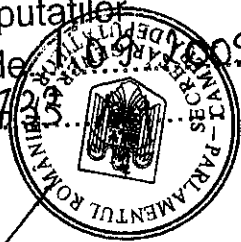

**Tema: Participarea la Conferința cu tema „Defrișările și schimbările climatice”
(Stockholm, 27-28 septembrie 2009)**

În perioada 27-28 septembrie 2009, la Stockholm, va avea loc Conferința cu tema „Defrișările și schimbările climatice”, organizată de Comisia pentru mediu și agricultură din Parlamentul Suediei, în contextul deținerii de către Suedia a președinției Uniunii Europene.

Evenimentul reunește parlamentari, președinți ai comisiilor pentru mediu din parlamentele naționale, reprezentanți ai organizațiilor nonguvernamentale, precum și experți în domeniul protecției mediului și al schimbărilor climatice. Pe agenda reuniunii sunt prevăzute dezbateri pe tema reducerii degradării pădurilor și a emisiilor cauzate de defrișări, precum și o intervenție a ministrului mediului din Suedia.

La această acțiune va participa doamna deputată **Sulfina Barbu** (PD-L), președinta Comisiei pentru administrație publică, amenajarea teritoriului și echilibru ecologic.

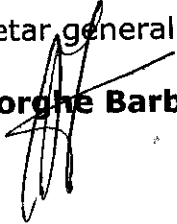
Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit. c) din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare din HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputate Sulfina Barbu la această acțiune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București – Budapesta – Stockholm și retur, cu plecare din București în 26 septembrie 2009, ora 06:10 (MA 857) și întoarcere în 29 septembrie 2009, ora 01:25 (MA 856), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 3 zile, cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.

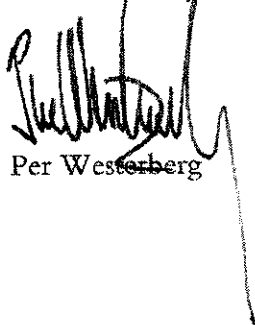

Dear Colleague,

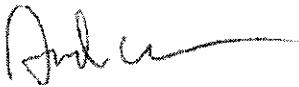
Climate change is one of the main priorities of the Swedish Presidency. Prior to Copenhagen, I believe it would be valuable to discuss and explore the subject, also from a parliamentary point of view, together with chairs of the other national parliaments. I am therefore very pleased to invite you to a meeting on the theme *Deforestation and Climate Change*.

The formal meeting will take place in the Swedish Parliament (the Riksdag) on Monday 28 September. We would, however, like to start on Sunday with a visit to Hammarby Sjöstad – a new district in Stockholm where the City has imposed tough environmental requirements on buildings, technical installations and the traffic environment – followed by dinner at the Vasa Museum, which hosts the only remaining, intact, 17th century ship in the world.

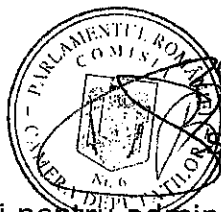
