Tema: Participarea domnului deputat Tudor Panțiru la cea de a treia parte a Sesiunii ordinare 2009 a Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei (22-26 iunie 2009, Strasbourg)

În perioada 22-26 iunie 2009, la Strasbourg va avea loc cea de a treia parte a sesiunii Adunării Parlamentare a Consiliului Europei, la care participă membrii Delegației Parlamentului României la APCE.

Un punct important pe ordinea de zi a sesiunii este reprezentat de alegerea noului Secretar general al Consiliului Europei de către membrii Adunării.

De asemenea, membrii Adunării vor dezbate și adopta o serie de rapoarte referitoare la situația drepturilor omului în Europa, criza economico-financiară la nivel mondial, protecția mediului și vor decerna Premiul APCE pentru Drepturile Omului.

La această acțiune urmează să participe, în perioada 24-26 iunie a.c., domnul deputat Tudor Panțiru, (Alianța politică PSD+PC), în calitate de supleant al domnului deputat Adrian Năstase în Delegația Parlamentului României la APCE, întrucât domnul deputat Adrian Năstase, vicepreședinte al Camerei Deputaților, are prevăzută participarea în perioada 24-27 iunie a.c. la sesiunea Forumului Crans Montana de la Bruxelles (Memorandumul Intern nr. 62a/681/11 mai 2009 aprobat în ședința Biroului permanent din 13 mai 2009).

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, litera a) din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

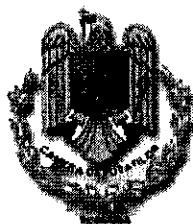
- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Tudor Panțiru la această acțiune;

- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul pe ruta București-Amsterdam-Strasbourg și retur, cu plecare din București în 23 iunie 2009, ora 6.05 (KL 1358) și întoarcere în 27 iunie 2009, ora 13.40 (KL 1389), conform traseului alăturat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 4 ½ cazare plafon B, în numerar, pentru 4 nopți, întrucât rezervările se efectuează prin intermediul Reprezentanței Permanente a României la Consiliul Europei, și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară pe baza documentelor justificative.
