MEMORANDUM INTERN

Tema: Participarea la Conferința europeană interparlamentară privind spațiul și la Seminarul cu tema „Explorarea și exploatarea spațiului în societatea modernă” (Londra, 20 mai 2009)

În data de 20 mai 2009, va avea loc, la Londra, Seminarul cu tema „Explorarea și exploatarea spațiului cosmic în societatea modernă”, urmat de lucrările Conferinței europene interparlamentare privind spațiul. Reuniunile sunt organizate sub egida Comisiei parlamentare pentru spațiu din Camera Comunelor a Parlamentului britanic, împreună cu Institutul European pentru Politica Spațiului Cosmic (European Space Policy Institute, ESPI), Institutul pentru fizică și Societatea Regală de Chimie din Marea Britanie.

Pe agenda reuniunilor sunt prevăzute teme precum „Descoperirea și explorarea spațiului”, „Impactul economic asupra finanțării cercetărilor privind spațiul” și analizarea propunerilor pentru următoarea președinție a Conferinței europene interparlamentare privind spațiul, deținută în prezent de Marea Britanie.

La aceste reuniuni, a fost invitată să participe doamna deputată **Liana Dumitrescu (Grupul parlamentar al minorităților naționale)**, președinta Subcomisiei pentru spațiu a Camerei Deputaților.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, lit. e din HBP 1/2003 cu modificările și completările ulterioare din HBP 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea doamnei deputate Liana Dumitrescu la aceste reuniuni;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București – Londra și retur, cu plecare în data de 19 mai 2009, ora 09:55 (RO 391) și întoarcere în data de 21 mai 2009, ora 17:50 (RO 392), conform traseului anexat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 2 ½ zile, drepturi de cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți, precum și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor se va face la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.
