**Tema: Participarea la reuniunea Grupului de la Viena pe probleme de
Migrație (16 octombrie 2009, Viena)**

La 16 octombrie 2009, la Viena, va avea loc reuniunea Grupului de la Viena pe probleme de Migrație, cu prilejul Zilei europene de combaterea a traficului de persoane, la care urmează să participe domnul deputat **Tudor Chiuariu** (PNL), membru al Comisiei pentru afaceri europene a Parlamentului României.

Reuniunea, la care vor lua parte reprezentanți ai Organizației Internaționale pentru Migrație (OIM), membri ai Parlamentului European, parlamentari din statele membre OIM, oficiali guvernamentali și specialiști în domeniu, se desfășoară sub genericul: „O abordare multidisciplinară cuprinzătoare privind traficul de persoane: o cooperare activă între statele de origine, tranzit și destinație”.

Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art. 3, litera e) din HBP nr. 1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

Propunem:

- să se aprobe participarea domnului deputat Tudor Chiuariu la această acțiune;
- deplasarea să se efectueze cu avionul, pe ruta București-Viena și retur, cu plecare în 15 octombrie 2009, ora 11.40 (OS 790) și întoarcere în 17 octombrie 2009, ora 16.25 (OS 791), conform traseului alăturat;
- să se acorde drepturi de diurnă categoria a II-a, 100%, pentru 2½ zile, cazare plafon B pentru 2 nopți și un avans de 50% cu decontare ulterioară;
- recalcularea cheltuielilor să se facă la întoarcerea în țară, pe baza documentelor justificative.
