industrie alimentară și servicii specifice, în baza invitației nominale primită de la EUFORES.

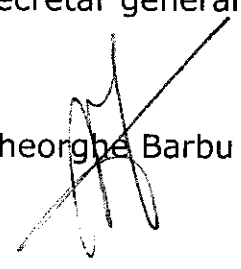
Acțiunea are caracter parlamentar conform art.3, lit. e) din HBP nr.1/2003 cu modificările și completările din HBP nr. 5/2007.

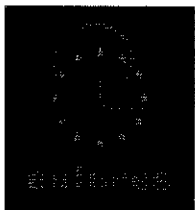

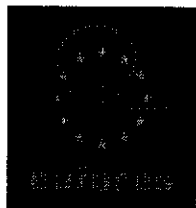
